**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

These rules and regulations are intended to supplement all Bond Resolutions and By-laws which have been enacted by the Company and which are incorporated by reference.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 12th and 24th of each month. The customer may read his own meter, if he wishes, but the Company will check read three times a year.

2. All bills shall be rendered monthly and shall be due and payable on the 1st of the following month. Bills shall be dated as of the meter reading date. Bills become delinquent on the 11th of the month and a 10% penalty will be added. A delinquent notice will be mailed on the 12th of each month and such notice will state that service shall be discontinued if not paid within a 30 day period from the date of said bill. If not paid in the 30 day period, a pull notice will be sent out by a collector and a \$5.00 service charge will be added.

3. The Company reserves the right to require a security deposit of \$25.00, said deposit may be used and applied to a final bill.

4. Complaints may be made to the office of the Company, 104 W. Maple St., Nicholasville, Ky. 40356, and may be appealed to the Company officers within 10 days.

5. Each house must be metered separately and the customer cannot give away or resell water without written consent of the Company.

6. The Company shall permit main line extensions According to the provisions of Title 807 KAR 2:040 Section 12.

7. No residence shall be served through a field connection.

8. The Company does not guarantee either pressure or flow on any fire hydrant nor the working condition of any such fire hydrant. The hydrant is installed merely as a convenience for the purpose of serving as a reloading station for fire fighting equipment. No one shall use any fire hydrant for any purpose other than fire fighting use.
