RULES AND REGULATIONS

 $\mathbf{E}\mathbf{x}$

These rules and regulations are intended to supp lement all bond resolutions, the rate resolutions and by-laws which have been enacted by the district and which are indorporated by reference.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 24th of each month,

2. Billw will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within 15 days. However, provisions contained in the rate resolution as to penalties; cut-offs and meter deposits will apply, and district may terminate service for failure to pay water bill.

3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission from district on the property to be served. 4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and his de-

cisions may be appealed to the district commission within 10 days,

The principal place of business of the district will be Waco, Kentucky. 5.

Water bills may be paid c/o Manager Waco Water District. 6.

The district shall serve all customers on the line in the district 7. unless the district deems it unfeasible to serve such customer basedon the district's determination that the present or future flow or pressure at the requested point of service will be unsatisfactory. Said determination can be nel made before or after the customer has obtained service and regardless of how long the customer has been served.

If the district determines a customer being served is being rendered 8. unsatisfactory service, the district shall notify the customer in writing of the date when service shall terminate and customer's connection fee shall, p prior to that date, be refunded by the district. The customer has no right to require service or recover damage from the district in the event of such disconnectionand refund of any connection fee paid by the customer.

9. In addition to standard connection fees, the ditrict can require thy developer of more than one lot (subdivider) or potential large user to furnish storage or pumping facilities or to enlarge supply lines or to. guarantee payment of a minimum bill over a period ofyears by special a contract.

10. The customer cannot give away or resell water without the written CHECKE consent of the district. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

11. Each house must be metered separately, unless the written consent of the district to do other wise is obtained.

12. Regulatory provisions of the rate resolutions, bylaws, if any, land bond ordinances are made a part of this rate resolution.

13. No residence shall be served through a Field Connection, if Field Connections are authorized by the rate tariff.

14. The district does not guarantee either pressure or flow on any fire hydrant nor the working condition of any such fire hydrant. Thehydrant is installed merely as a convenience for the purpose of serving as a re-loading station for fire fighting equipment. No one shall use any fire hydrant for any purpose other than fire fighting use.

15. These rules may be amended by the district commission
