A penalty of 10% will be added to all unpaid bills after the due date of the 10th of each month.

A deposit of 2/12ths of the estimated annual bill may be charged for each account or service. Deposits may be recalculated upon request of the customer. Interest will be paid on all deposits at the present day bank rate. The interest will be applied as a credit to the customer's bill or will be paid to the customer on an annual basis. If the deposit is re-funded or credited to the customer's bill prior to the deposit anniversary date, interest will be paid or credited to the customer's bill on a pro-rated basis. If interest is not credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer annually, interest will be computed by a method which will result in an amount no less than that obtained by using a middle course method between simple and compound interest in compliance with Commission Order dated October 31, 1989 in Case No. 89-057. Interest on deposits computed in this manner will accrue until credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer.

A charge of \$10.00 is made for each meter for each turn-on.

Where two adjacent lots need water service and in the event that a double meter box is a reasonable connection method, then in that event the sum of \$450.00 shall be assessed to the developer or the lot owners in lieu of the standard \$~~400.00~~ connection fee per lot.

Where there is an existing subdivision and said developer has already installed an approved meter vault, and all other connections excluding the meter, there shall be a charge of \$65.00 to install the meter in the existing meter vault. This procedure is commonly known as a "meter drop."

XII. Complaints - Adjustments

A. If the customer believes his bill to be in error, he shall present his claim, in person or in writing the District Commission before the bill becomes delinquent. Such claim, if made after the bill has become delinquent, shall not be effective in preventing discontinuance of service, heretofore provided. The customer may pay such bill under a protest and said payment shall not prejudice his claim.

B. The Water District will make special meter readings at the request of the customer for a fee of Ten (10.00), provided, however, that if such special reading discloses that the meter was overread, no charge will be made.

C. Meters will be tested at the request of the customer, for a fee of Fifteen (\$15.00) provided, however if test discloses that meter was in error no charge will be made.

D. If the seal of a meter is broken by other than the Water District's representative or if the meter fails to register correctly or is stopped for any cause the customer shall pay an amount estimated from the record of the previous bills and/or from other proper data.

XIII. Abridgement or Modification of Rules

A. No promise, agreement or representation of any employee of the Water District shall be binding upon the District except as it shall have been agreed upon in writing, signed and accepted by the acknowledged commissions of the Water District.

B. No modification of rates or any of the rules and regulations shall be made by any agent of the Water District.

C. The words "Water District" used herein applies to the White Hall Water District and the word "customer" used herein applies to the customers of the Water District.

I. Service Classification. There shall be no distinction of this category.

II. Service Application.

A. The Water District may reject any application by a customer when the applicant is delinquent in payment of bills for service previously supplied at any location.

B. Violation of any of the provisions of these rules, by-laws or any other regulations of the Water District, and the Water District may remove the meter and discontinue service. Where the meter is thereafter reinstalled, the customer shall first pay to the Water District a reinstallation charge of \$15.00. Customers receiving service as a part of an extension of service are required to contract for service for one year. Such customers shall pay for service according to the rates in effect or the minimum monthly rate, which ever is greater, whether or not the customer uses the service.

C. The individual in whose name the customer certificate is prepared shall be responsible for all bills incurred. Customers shall be responsible for their own bills.. Customers shall pay the applicable deposit before meter is turned on.

III. Initial or Minimum Charges.

A. The flat, monthly rate, as set up in the water rate schedule for the year will be payable irrespective of whether any water is used by the customer during any month. Customer shall not be charged for any month where service has been discontinued.

B. In the event the Water District may be required to remove the meter for non-payment of bills, the Water District, when service is again restored, will make a charge for such reinstallation of \$15.00.

C. The minimum tap fee of \$400.00 shall be made for each new meter installation where a 5/8 X 3/4 inch meter is used regardless of location. Each meter requires a separate meter reading sheet, and each meter reading sheet will cover a separate and individual account.

D. Water furnished for a given lot or farmstead shall be used on that lot only. Each customer's service must be separately metered at a single delivery and metering point. All commercial use, including storerooms and stalls for business purposes, shall be metered separately from any residential use and vice versa.

E. In addition to the collection of the regular rates, the Water District may collect from the customer a proportionate share of any privilege, sales or use tax or impositions based on gross revenue received by the Water District

IV. Water District's Responsibility

A. The Water District will install, maintain and operate a main distribution pipeline or lines from the source of water supply and service lines from the main distribution line or lines to the property line of each customer of the Water District at which point, designated as delivery points, meters to be purchased, installed, owned and maintained by the Water district shall be placed. The cost of the service line or lines from the main distribution line or lines of the Water District to the property line of each customer shall be paid by the Water District. The Water District will also purchase and install a cut-off valve in each service line from its main distribution line or lines, such cut-off valve to be owned and maintained by the Water District and to be installed on same portion of the service line owned by the Water District. The Water District shall have the sole and exclusive right to use of such cut-off valve to turn it on and off.

B. Each customer shall be entitled to not to exceed one (1) service line from the Water District's water system unless otherwise approved by the Commissioners and provided that the customer shall be required to pay the prevalent tap fee for each service line. No new service line or change in an existing service line may be made which will interfere with an existing service line or the delivery of water therein. Each service line shall connect with the Water District's water system at the nearest available place to the place of desired use by the customer if the Water District's water system shall be sufficient in capacity to permit the delivery of water through a service line at that place without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line. If the Water District's water system shall be inadequate to permit the delivery of water through a service line installed at such place without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line, then such service line shall be installed at such place as may be designated by the Water District. Each customer will be required to dig or have dug a ditch, to purchase and install and maintain such portion of the service line or lines from the property line of the customer to his own dwelling; or other place of use on his premises at his own expense, provided that the Water District may, at the customer's request and if the Commission so elect, purchase the pipe for and install such portion of such service line or lines, the cost of which will, however, be paid by the individual customers.

C. The Water District will cause an initial inspection to be made of the customer's piping or apparatus to ensure compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

V. Water District's Liability

A. The Water District reserves the right to refuse service unless the customer's lines or piping are installed in such manner as to prevent cross-connections or back flow.

B. The Water District shall not be liable for damage of any kind whatsoever resulting from water or the use of water on the customer's premises, unless such damage results directly from negligence on the part of the District. The Water District shall not be responsible for any damage done by or ~~to~~ ^{resulting from} ~~any~~ defects in piping, fixtures or appliances on the customer's premises. ~~The Water District shall not be responsible for negligence of the third persons or forces beyond the control of the District resulting in any interruption of service.~~

C. Under normal conditions, the customers will be notified of any anticipated interruption of service.

VI. Customer's Responsibility

A. Piping on the premises of the customer must be installed so that the connections are conveniently located with respect to Water District lines and mains.

B. If the Water District is called upon to provide additional meters, each place of metering will be considered as a separate and individual account.

C. The customer shall provide a place of metering, which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.

D. The customer shall furnish and maintain a private cut-off valve on the customer's side of the meter. The District is to provide a like valve on the Water District's side of such meter.

E. The customer's piping and apparatus shall be installed and maintained by the customer at the customer's expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the Water District's rules and regulations and in full compliance with sanitary regulations of the State Board of Health.

F. The customer shall guarantee proper protection for the Water District's property placed on the customer's premises and shall permit access to it only by authorized representatives of the District.

G. In the event that any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful act of the customer, his agent or employees, the District reserves the right to seek the recovery of the necessary repairs or replacements through a court of competent jurisdiction. Nothing stated in these rules and regulations shall be deemed a waiver of this right.

H. Water furnished by the District shall be used for domestic consumption by the customer, members of his household and employees only. The customer shall not sell water to any other person or permit any other person to use said water. Water shall not be used for irrigation, fire protection or other purposes except that when water is available in sufficient quantity without interfering with the regular domestic consumption, then the water may be used for such other purposes. Disregard for this rule shall be sufficient cause for refusal or discontinuance of service.

VII. Extensions to Mains and Services.

A. The Water District will supply service for temporary purposes, provided that the District has water available in excess of its regular needs, and provided the District has available material and equipment necessary to supply said service. Each applicant for such service must pay in advance to the District the District's estimate of cost of labor and materials, less salvage value on removal, for installing and removing such service.

B. An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by the Water District to its existing distribution main without charge to a customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more.

C. When an extension of the District's main to serve a customer amounts to more than fifty (50) feet per customer, the District shall require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet per customer to be deposited with the utility by the customer, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension.

D. Each customer receiving service under such an extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the Water District shall refund to the customer who paid for the excessive footage the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period, no refund will be required to be made.

may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension. Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years the Water District shall refund to the customer who paid for the extension of a sum equivalent to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the District. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension no refund will be required to be made.

VII. Access to Premises.

A. Duly authorized agents of the Water District shall have access, at all reasonable hours, to the premises of the customer for the purpose of installing or removing Water District property, inspecting piping, reading or testing meters or for any other purpose in connection with the District's service and facilities.

B. Each customer shall grant or convey, or shall cause to be granted or conveyed to the Water District a permanent easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said permanent easement and right-of-way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines, so as to be able to furnish service to the customer.

IX. Change of Occupancy

A. Not less than one weeks notice must be given in person or in writing to the Water District to discontinue service or to change occupancy.

B. The outgoing party shall be responsible for all water consumed up to the time designated for discontinuance of service.

C. A charge of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars will be made for each meter for each turn-on.

X. Meter Reading - Billing - Collection

A. Meters will be read and bills rendered monthly, indicating the meter reading and the billing dates but the Water District reserves the right to vary the dates or length or period covered, temporarily or permanently if necessary or desirable.

B. Bills for water will be figured in accordance with the Water District's published rate schedule and will be based on the amount consumed for the period covered by the meter readings.

C. Charge for service commences when the meter is installed and connection made, whether used or not.

D. Reading from different meters will not be combined for billing, irrespective of the fact that said meters may be for the same or different premises, or the same or different customers, or for the same or different services.

E. Bills are due when rendered and become delinquent ten (10) days after due date.

F. Delinquent notices will be mailed to the customer ten (10) days after the regular monthly billing date and if payment is not made within thirty (30) days after due date, written notice of intention to disconnect services will be mailed to last known address. Notice to disconnect shall be given at least 48 hours before disconnection.

G. Failure to receive bills or notices shall not prevent such bills from becoming delinquent nor relieve the customer from payment.

XI. Suspension of Service

B. Upon discontinuance of service for non-payment of bills, the deposit will be applied by the District toward settlement of the account.

C. Service discontinued for non-payment of bills will be restored only after bills are paid in full and a reconnection fee of Fifteen (15.00) Dollars will be paid for each meter reconnected.

D. The Water District reserves the right to discontinue its service for the following reasons:

1. Without notice, for customer's fraudulent or illegal use of service.
2. For customer's non-payment of bills. However, the District shall first make all reasonable effort to induce customer to pay the bill, and thereafter, customer shall be given at least 48 hours written notice, mailed to his last known address. In no event shall service be cut off before the 20th day after the date on which the original bill was mailed to the customer. In the event customer submits a written certificate of a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer to the District stating that discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the effective premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make living arrangements or until 10 days lapse from the date of the District's written notice, whichever occurs first.
