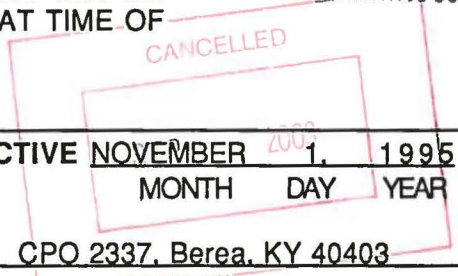

- (a) Applicable: To all customers in the city of Berea and contiguous territory thereto.
- (b) Availability of Service: This rate schedule is available, for the various types of street lighting services shown herein. Service is subject to the provisions herein and the provisions of Berea College Electric Utility's standard contract for street lighting service.
- (c) Conditions of Service:

- 1. Duration: Service shall be from dusk to dawn, automatically controlled, approximately 4,000 hour per year.
- 2. Standard Overhead System: Street lighting equipment furnished under the Standard Overhead Rate shall consist of wooden poles, brackets, appropriate fixtures for lamps being used, the necessary overhead street lighting circuit, protective equipment, controls and transformers. Berea College Electric Utility will, install own, operate and maintain the entire street lighting system, including circuits, lighting fixtures and lamp replacement. The Customer shall pay the Standard Overhead Rate.

When the Customer request service under the Standard Overhead System and the Customer desires other than a wooden pole, Berea College Electric Utility may furnish the required pole(s) and, when required by pole type, fixture(s) at an additional charge per month to be determined by Berea College Electric Utility. The additional charges are subject to change by Berea College Electric Utility upon 30 days prior written notice.

- 3. Standard Overhead System on Existing Poles: Private outdoor lighting equipment furnished under the Standard Overhead on Existing Pole Rate shall consist of bracket(s), appropriate fixture(s) for lamp(s) being used, the necessary overhead lighting circuit, protective equipment, controls and transformers. Berea College Electric Utility will, install own, operate and maintain the entire private outdoor lighting system, including circuits, lighting fixtures and lamp replacement. The Customer shall pay the Standard System on Existing Pole Rate when private outdoor lighting is installed on an existing pole.

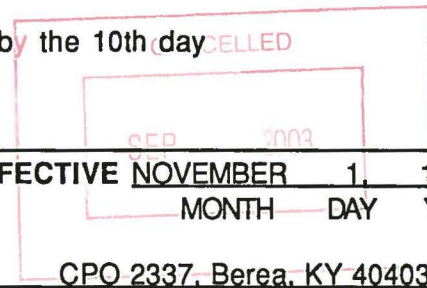
