(b) The annual minimum charge for schools, churches and community halls shall be \$20.00 per year, except where the necessary transformer capacity for any one customer exceeds 3 kva.

(c) If the transformer capacity for any customer under (b) above exceeds 3 kva, that customer shall be billed at the minimum set out under (a) above.

(d) Under (a) energy will be supplied in accordance with the rate schedule set out above. Under (b) energy will be supplied under the rate schedule set out above, except that the first 40 kwh's used per month shall be billed at the rate of 7.5¢ per kwh.

Delayed Payment Charge:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, five percent (5%) will be added to the bill.

Special Rules:

(a) Service under this schedule is available for farm and home uses including lighting, incidental appliances, refrigeration, cooking, and power for motors up to and including ten horsepower or a total connected motor load not in excess of fifteen horsepower.

(b) This schedule will apply to the great majority of rural customers. It applies only to single-phase service, however, and, if a farm has a motor larger than ten horsepower or a total motor load in excess of fifteen horsepower, three-phase service is required and the farm should be served on Schedule B.

If the customer's connected load requires the Cooperative to install an unusually large transformer, the minimum monthly charge is increased as provided in Section 1 under the heading "Minimum Charges" in order to cover fixed charges on the Cooperative's added investment in the transformer and other equipment.

Minimum Charges to Schools, Churches and Community Halls

(c) Minimum charges to schools, churches and community halls are made less than other customers and are placed on an annual basis. This is recommended because they are public, non-profit institutions and because the use of their buildings is seasonal, particularly in the case of schools.

It is not intended that the annual minimum be converted into a monthly minimum charge. In consequence there is no charge to schools, for examples, during the summer months, provided no energy is used. As explained on page 25, of the REA Rate Handbook, bills are rendered to these customers each month during which energy is used, but with no minimum charge. These bills are to be paid monthly as is expected of all other customers. At the end of the calendar year, or at the end of any other 12 months period designated by the Board of Directors, the total of the 12 monthly bills is compared to the annual minimum. If the total is less than the annual minimum, a charge for the difference is added to the bill for the twelfth month. If the total of the 12 monthly bills is equal to or greater than the annual minimum, the bill for the twelfth month will contain only the charge for energy used that month. Further information on this class of service is contained in the REA Rate Handbook on page 3, 15 and 25.

Minimum Charges for Water Pumps and Barns

The minimum charge for water pumps and barns not requiring more than 3 KVA and operated by farmer having an additional meter on the farm at regular rate and does not require more than 1000 feet of construction will be on an annual basis of \$20.00 per year.

The basis for this rate is to keep farmers with seasonal water pumps for watering stock and for tobacco barns and stripping rooms which are only used on seasonal basis, These services being too far to be connected to main dwelling on farm.

(a) The customers will give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount, and duration of the business offered.

(b) The customer will guarantee a minimum monthly bill for three-phase service which will be computed on the basis of 1½ percent of the additional investment, which includes additional cost of transformers, necessary to make three-phase service available. The minimum bill will be effective for a period of three (3) years from the date on which service commences. After this period the regular monthly minimum charge will be effective.

(c) In no case, however, will the minimum bill for three-phase service be less than the previously specified "Minimum Monthly Charge".

Special Rules:

(a) Single-phase Power Service is limited to a single motor not in excess of twenty-five horsepower. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.

(b) Service under this schedule is limited to customers whose load requirements can be met by a transformer having a capacity not to exceed 25 kva.

At least 200 kwh must be billed under Schedule A before the off-peak rate is used.

II. METHOD OF METERING OFF-PEAK CONSUMPTION.

Available to customers taking service under Schedule B and those customers taking service under Schedule A having water heating installations in which the capacity of any heating element exceeds 2,500 watts or in which the estimated off-peak consumption exceeds 300 kwh per month.

For all such customers the Corporation shall install an additional meter to register the consumption of the off-peak heating element, and all energy consumed by the off-peak heating element shall be billed at the aforesaid off-peak rate, providing that at least 100 kwh per month shall be billed on Schedule A or B as the case may require before any energy is billed on the off-peak rate and provided further that if the customer is using an electric range at least 200 kwh per month shall be billed on Schedule A or B before any energy is billed on the off-peak rate.

Power Factor Adjustment:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 kw or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge:

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel-cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per kwh as the fuel cost adjustment per kwh in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

3. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
4. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of 10% shall apply to the demand and energy charges; and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.
