**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

16. DEPOSIT

The Cooperative may require a deposit not exceeding one-twelfth (1/12) of the estimated annual bill to secure payment of bills, except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. All deposits shall be based on actual usage of the customer at the same or similar premises for the most recent 12 month period, if such information is available. If usage information is not available, the deposit will be based on the average bills of similar customers and premises in the system. The deposit amount shall not exceed 1/12 of the customer's actual or estimated annual bill. Service may be refused or disconnected for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived for customers or previous customers who have established a satisfactory credit history, and required deposits will be returned after one year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The cooperative may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account of from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential

customer, the Cooperative may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the only criteria considered is for customers who have previously received electric service from Fox Creek RECC and have established a satisfactory credit history. For those customers, the deposit will be waived.

Fox Creek RECC makes a cost estimate for constructing the line underground for each member requesting underground primary service. The cost of overhead construction is taken from the estimated cost of underground construction and the member pays the difference.

If rock is encountered or other procedures are used to obtain proper burial depth, the actual additional cost shall also apply.

In cases involving subdivision development, loop feed shall be incorporated into the underground construction.

The member also has the option of opening and closing the ditch, providing and installing conduit and a concrete transformer pad. If the member chooses to take these options, they must meet Fox Creek RECC's specifications and the underground line would be treated as an overhead line.
