10. RECONNECTION CHARGES

The Cooperative shall make only one service connection without charge for the same consumer at the same location. After the original no-charge connection is made, subsequent reconnections will carry a \$5.00 reconnection charge. In the event a reconnection would be made after working hours, the charge therefor will be \$10.00.

11. RESALE OF POWER BY MEMBERS

All purchased electric service used on the premises of the member shall be supplied exclusively by the Cooperative and the member shall not directly or indirectly sell, sublet, or otherwise dispose of the electric service or any part thereof.

12. SERVICE CALLS

If a member or customer makes a request for a service call from the Cooperative to do special work on their premises or equipment other than the Cooperative's property, a charge of 15¢ per mile plus labor plus material will be made, and be it further known that the Cooperative is not liable or responsible in any way for work done on member's or customer's premises for said service calls. (C)

13. UNDERGROUND SERVICE

Underground secondary service to new homes will be furnished by the Cooperative upon request provided the owner, at his expense, opens and closes the trench from the pole to the point of meter location in accordance with the specifications hereinafter set out. Underground services to existing homes will be installed under the provisions of this policy. (C)

14. EXTENSIONS FOR SEASONAL LOADS

It is the desire and intention of the Cooperative to make service available to all persons and property within the Cooperative's operating area consistent with sound economy and good management. Extensions will be built to barns, to field water systems and to other seasonal loads only on a five-year contract which shall be signed by the owner of the property. The maximum distance of the extension will be 1,000 feet for the regular existing monthly minimum.

For extensions greater than 1,000 feet from the nearest facility, the

D. Consumer Equipment

18. POINT OF DELIVERY

The point of delivery is the point as designated by the Cooperative on member's premises where current is to be delivered to building or premises, namely the weatherhead. All wiring and equipment beyond this point of delivery shall be supplied and maintained by the member. The consumer shall pay for additional installation in advance. The member will, however, notify the Cooperative of any proposed changes in his equipment or wiring which will materially increase or decrease his load so the Cooperative may check its equipment to make certain it will accommodate the consumer's load requirement.

19. CONSUMER'S WIRING

All wiring of the member must conform to Cooperative's requirements and accepted modern standards. The member agrees to construct its facilities in accordance with specifications at least equal to those prescribed by the National Electrical Safety Code and the National Electric Code. The Cooperative, however, assumes no responsibility in respect to the type, standard of construction, protective equipment or the condition of the member's property, and will not be liable for any loss or injury to persons or property occurring on the premises or property of the member. The member agrees to operate and maintain its facilities so as not to interfere with the service of the Cooperative to its other members. The member will have complete responsibility for all construction, operation, and maintenance beyond the weatherhead and will save the Cooperative harmless against liability for injury or damages resulting in any manner from construction, location, operation, or maintenance of the member's facilities. 20. INSPECTIONS

Prior to the connection of the electric lines of the Cooperative to any building, either residential, commercial, business, factory, or any type whatever, the person desiring electric service shall furnish to the Cooperative a certificate of an inspector appointed by the County Fiscal Court or of an employee of Harrison RECC who has been certified by the Kentucky Public Service Commission showing that the wiring in said building fully complies with all the rules and regulations of the National Electric Code of the National Board of Fire Underwriters as adopted for the Cooperative area, and is in a safe and satisfactory condition. Until such certificate has been furnished, the lines of the Cooperative are not to be connected to said premises; provided that this rule shall not apply where temporary service is desired on a pole or temporary building during the construction of any permanent building and service is to be of a temporary nature only. Such inspection shall not render the Cooperative liable or responsible for any loss or damage which may occur on member's premises. (C)

E. Electric Bills

21. BILLING AND COLLECTION POLICY

Members will receive statements for electric service on the first day of each month for service rendered for a thirty-day period ending the fifth of the preceding month. All statements are due and payable upon receipt and shall be paid at the office of the Cooperative within ten (10) days from first of month. Failure to receive electrical statement will not release the member from payment obligation. Should the statement not be paid as above, the Cooperative may at any time thereafter on a five (5) days' notice to the member discontinue service.

A \$5.00 fee is to be collected on first call and on all subsequent calls for purposes of collecting delinquent accounts during regular working hours. The Cooperative reserves the right to require additional payment for trips made other than during regular working hours.

No consumer is to be reconnected at any location without first having paid all previous indebtedness to Cooperative.

22. METER READING

Each member receiving service will be required to supply the Cooperative with the reading of each meter on the form as furnished by the Cooperative, on such date as designated by the Cooperative. Readings not received on time will be estimated. On the third consecutive estimate, an employee of the Cooperative will read the meter and a \$5.00 service charge may be added to such member's account.

23. UNPAID CHECKS FROM CONSUMERS

When a check received in payment of a consumer's account is returned unpaid by the bank for any reason, the Cooperative will notify such consumer by letter stating the amount of the check and the reason for its return. Returned checks will be considered same as a delinquent account.

In the event a customer pays by check which is returned by the bank, for each additional returned check within each twelve (12) month period, an added charge of \$5.00 will be made to cover collection costs. If it becomes necessary to make a collection trip an additional \$5.00 charge will be made.

F. Phase Converter Policy

(N)

When it is not practical to extend three-phase service to a member and a phase converter can be used, the member will bear the expense for a converter that will accommodate a 10-horsepower motor.

For motors in excess of 10 horsepower, the Cooperative will supply the converter.

G. Distribution Line Extensions to Mobile Homes

(N)

The Cooperative will extend service to mobile homes where the member owns the property on the same terms it extends service to any other residential consumer.

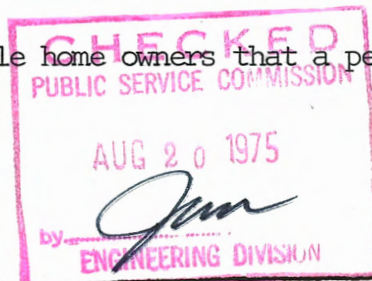
Service will be extended to mobile homes located on rental lots up to a distance of 300 feet with no charge.

For extensions greater than 300 feet from the nearest facility, the Cooperative will charge an advance (deposit) equal to the reasonable costs incurred by it for that portion of the service beyond 300 feet plus \$50.00.

- (a) This advance (deposit) shall be refunded to the customer over a four-year period in equal amounts for each year the service is continued.
- (b) If the service is discontinued for a period of 60 days, or should the mobile home be removed and another not take its place within 60 days, or be replaced by a permanent structure, the remainder of the advance (deposit) shall be forfeited.
- (c) No refunds shall be made to any consumer who did not make the advance (deposit) originally.

It is strongly recommended to all mobile home owners that a permanent sewage system be installed.
