5. RELOCATION OF LINES BY REQUEST OF MEMBERS

In the event the Cooperative is asked to move an existing line, poles, guys and/or anchors for the construction of buildings or other reasons, the member shall pay the total cost. (T)

B. Service Procedures

6. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Each prospective member desiring electric service will be required to sign the Cooperative's form, "Application for Membership and for Electric Service", before service is supplied by the Cooperative and provide the Cooperative with necessary easements or right-of-way permits.

7. MEMBERSHIP FEE

The fee for membership in the Corporation shall be \$25 for all new memberships after April 30, 1977. All memberships can be transferred from one location to another by the member. The membership fee will be refunded when all bills are paid or applied to any unpaid bills of the member at the time service is discontinued, which will automatically terminate the membership.

8. RIGHT OF ACCESS

The Cooperative's identified employees shall have access to member's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading meter, testing, repairing, removing, or exchanging any and all equipment belonging to the Cooperative. The members of the Cooperative shall grant to it, easement over land owned by them for the distribution lines of the Cooperative, without charge to the Cooperative.

9. MEMBER'S DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Any member desiring service discontinued or changed from one location to another shall give the Cooperative notice in person or in writing provided such notice does not violate contractual obligations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

10. RECONNECTION CHARGES:

The Cooperative shall make only one service connection without charge for the same consumer at the same location. After the original no-charge connection is made, subsequent reconnections will carry a \$10.00 reconnection charge. In the event a reconnection would be made after working hours, the charge therefor will be \$25.00.

11. RESALE OF POWER BY MEMBERS:

All purchased electric service used on the premises of the member shall be supplied exclusively by the Cooperative and the member shall not directly or indirectly sell, sublet, or otherwise dispose of the electric service or any part thereof.

12. SERVICE CALLS:

If a member or customer makes a request for a service call from the Cooperative to do special work on their premises or equipment other than the Cooperative's property, a reasonable charge for labor and mileage plus materials will be made, and be it further known that the Cooperative is not liable or responsible in any way for work done on the member's or customer's premises for said service calls.

13. UNDERGROUND SERVICE:

Underground secondary service to new homes will be furnished by the Cooperative upon request provided the owner, at his expense, opens and closes the trench from the pole to the point of meter location in accordance with the specifications hereinafter set out. Underground services to existing homes will be installed under the provisions of this policy.

14. DISTRIBUTION LINE EXTENSIONS:

A. Normal Extensions. An extension of 1,000 feet or less shall be made by the Cooperative to its existing distribution line without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use the service for one (1) year or more and provides guarantee for such service. The "service drop" to the house from the distribution line at the last pole shall not be included in the foregoing measurements.

B. Other Extensions. For extensions greater than 1,000 feet from the nearest facility, the

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Cooperative will charge an advance payment equal to the reasonable costs incurred by it for that portion of the service beyond 1,000 feet.

- (a) This advance payment shall be refunded over a 10-year period only if additional connections are made on this line. Refunds will be prorated based on the amortization of the customer's investment over a 10-year period.
- (b) If the service is discontinued for a period of 60 days, the remainder of the advance payment shall be forfeited.
- (c) No refunds shall be made to any consumer who did not make the advance payment originally.

C. Meters

15. METER TESTS

All new meters shall be checked for accuracy before installation. The Cooperative will at its own expense, make periodical tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain a high standard of accuracy and to conform with the regulations of the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission. The Cooperative will make additional tests of meters at the request of the member provided the member does not request such test more than once in twelve (12) months and upon payment of a fee of Four Dollars (\$4.00) paid in advance. When the test made at the member's request shows that the meter is accurate within 2% fast or slow, no adjustment will be made to the member's bill and the fee paid will be forfeited to cover the cost of requested test. When the test shows the meter to be in excess of 2% fast or slow, an adjustment shall be made to the member's bill for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months and the cost of testing the meter found to be inaccurate will be borne by the Cooperative and the Four Dollars (\$4.00) fee paid by the member will be refunded. If meters are found upon test to register fast and if time for periodic test has overrun to the extent that one-half (1/2) of the time elapsed since the last previous test exceeds twelve (12) months, the refund shall be for the twelve (12) months and a like refund for those months exceeding the periodic test period.

16. FAILURE OF METER TO REGISTER

In the event a member's meter should fail to register, the member shall be billed from the date of such failure at the average consumption of the member based on the three (3) month period immediate preceding the failure.

17. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY COOPERATIVE

The Cooperative may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of services, or for nonpayment of bills.

When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused, provided that the utility notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the

E. Electric Bills

21. BILLING AND COLLECTION POLICY

Members will receive statements for electric service on the first day of each month for service rendered for a thirty-day period ending the fifth of the preceding month. All statements are due and payable upon receipt and shall be paid at the office of the Cooperative within ten (10) days from the first of the month. Failure to receive electrical statement will not release the member from payment obligation. Should the statement not be paid, within the limits prescribed by the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission, service may be discontinued.

A \$10.00 fee will be charged for the purpose of collecting a delinquent account in conformance with the rules set by the Energy Regulatory Commission.

No consumer is to be reconnected at any location without first having paid all previous indebtedness to the Cooperative.

22. METER READING

Each member receiving service will be required to supply the Cooperative with the reading of each meter on the form as furnished by the Cooperative, on such date as designated by the Cooperative. Readings not received on time will be estimated. On the third consecutive estimate, an employee of the Cooperative will read the meter and \$10.00 service charge may be added to such member's account.

23. UNPAID CHECKS FROM CONSUMERS

When a check received in payment of a consumer's account is returned unpaid by the bank for any reason, the Cooperative will notify such consumer by letter stating the amount of the check and the reason for its return. Returned checks will be considered same as a delinquent account.

In the event a consumer pays by check which is returned by the bank, for each additional returned check within each twelve (12)-month period, an added charge of \$5.00 will be made to cover collection costs. If it becomes necessary to make a collection trip, an additional \$10.00 charge will be made.

24. BUDGET BILLING

Members have an opportunity to sign agreements with the Cooperative for spreading billing evenly over a twelve (12)-month period. The billing is based on estimated consumption made by a Cooperative representative.

In June, the end of the twelve-month period, the difference between payments and actual usage is adjusted by adding or crediting the difference of the regular electric service bill. Copy of the agreement is made a part of Rules and Regulations.

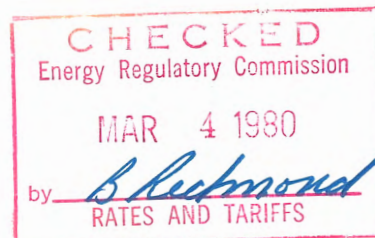
