DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The measured demand will be adjusted for consumers with more than 50 KW of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the amount per KWhr of sales by the Seller equal to the wholesale power cost for the next preceding month.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine (9) months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the consumer, and in no event shall it be less than twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing paragraph.

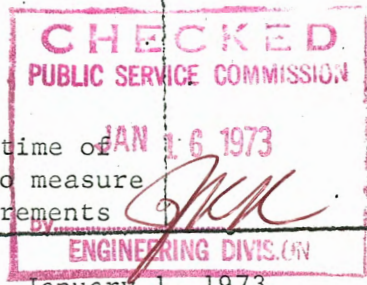

The maximum demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a maximum demand meter installed by the Cooperative.

POWER FACTOR

The consumer agrees to maintain a power factor of 80% at the time of his monthly maximum demand. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor of the consumer at any time. Should such measurements

5. In those cases where additional investment is required for three-phase service, it will be rendered only after the following conditions are met:

- (a) The consumer will give satisfactory assurance of a written agreement as to the character, amount and duration of the business offered.
- (b) The consumer will guarantee a minimum monthly bill for the three-phase service which will be computed on the basis of 1½% of the additional investment, which includes the additional cost of transformers necessary to make three-phase service available. The minimum bill be effective for a period of three (3) years from the date on which service commences. After this period, the regular monthly minimum charge will be effective.
- (c) In no case, however, will the minimum bill for three-phase service be less than the previously specified "Minimum Monthly Charge".

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All of the above rates are net, the gross rates being five per cent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill the gross rate shall apply. Delinquent accounts are subject to a collection fee of \$5.00 or disconnection of service.
