RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Application for service:

Each prospective member desiring electric service will be required to sign the Cooperative's form of application for membership before service is supplied by the Cooperative.

2. Membership fee:

The applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the applicant's membership fee. If the Cooperative is unable to furnish service to the applicant, the sum of \$5.00 will be returned to the applicant.

3. Deposits:

A deposit or suitable guarantee approximately equal to twice the average monthly bill may be required of any member, with a minimum of \$15.00, before service is supplied if the Cooperative deems it necessary to insure payment for the service it will render. Upon termination of service, deposit may be applied against unpaid bills of the member and if any balance remains after such application is made said balance to be refunded to the member.

4. Monthly bills for service:

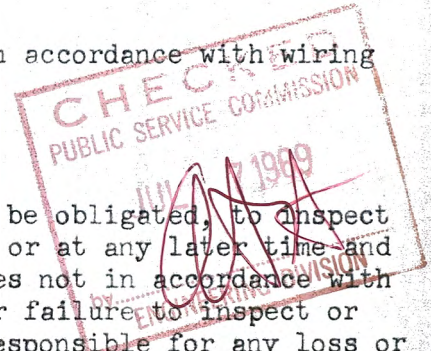
The applicant will, when electric energy becomes available and the meter installed, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy on his premises and will pay therefor monthly at rates which will be fixed by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative of at least \$2.50 per month.

5. Consumer's wiring:

The applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative.

6. Inspection:

The Cooperative shall have the right, but shall not be obligated, to inspect any installations before electricity is introduced or at any later time and reserves the right to reject any wiring or appliances not in accordance with the Cooperative's standards; but such inspection or failure to inspect or reject shall not render the Cooperative liable or responsible for any loss or damage resulting from defects in the installation, wiring, or appliances, or from violation of Cooperative's rules, or from accidents which may occur upon members' premises.

7. Right of Access:

The Cooperative's identified employees shall have access to members premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of reading meters, testing, repairing, removing or exchanging any or all equipment belonging to the Cooperative.

8. Consumer's responsibility:

The applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the charter and by-laws of the Cooperative, of which he will be a member, and such rules and regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the Cooperative. All meters, service connections and other equipment furnished by the Cooperative shall be, and remain, the property of the Cooperative. The member shall exercise proper care to protect the property of the Cooperative on its premises; and in the event of loss or damage to Cooperative's property arising from neglect of member to care for same, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by member.

9. Billing:

Bills will be rendered and mailed monthly. All bills shall be paid each month on or before the payment date shown on the bill at the office of the Cooperative or its regular authorized collection agencies. Failure to receive the bill will not release the member from payment obligation. Should bills not be paid as above the Cooperative may at any time thereafter, on ten (10) days notice to the member, discontinue service. Bills paid on or before the payment date shall be payable at the net rates but if paid after the payment date, a penalty of 10% will be added to the bill. Should the payment date fall on Sunday or a holiday the next business day following will be the final day for the next bill. All remittances received by the Cooperative after the payment date will be accepted in net amounts if the incoming envelope bears United States Post-Office date stamp of the payment date or a date prior thereto.

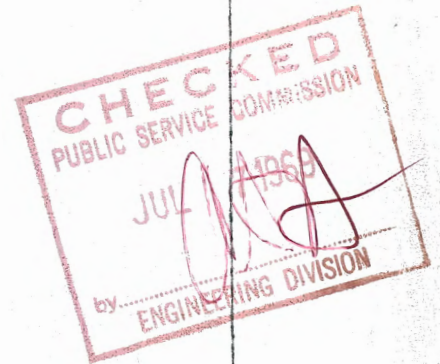

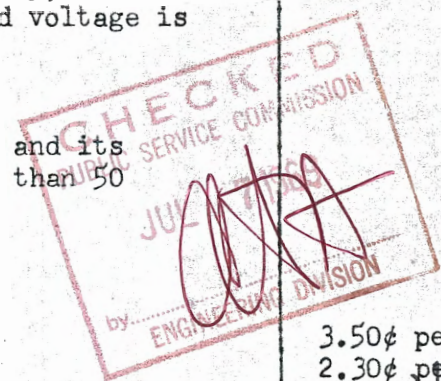

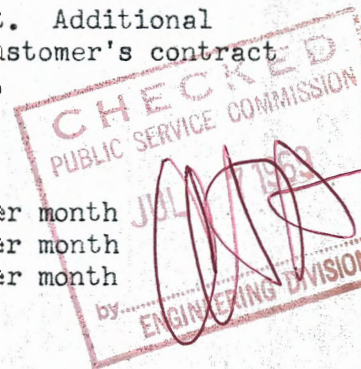

Facilities Rental Charges Applicable under C.

No facilities rental charge is applicable for delivery at 161 kv. For delivery at less than 161 kv, the customer will pay, in addition to all other charges hereunder, a facilities rental charge of 15¢ per kw per month for the first 10,000 kw of the customer's contract demand and 5 cents per kw per month for the portion of contract demand which is in excess of 10,000 kw except that, for delivery at less than 46 kv, 20 cents shall apply in lieu of 15 cents in the first portion of said facilities rental charge.

Adjustments.

- Under A, B and C, the customer's bill for each month will be increased or decreased by 0.01 mill per kwh for each 0.01 mill or major fraction thereof by which TVA's fossil and nuclear fuel expense per kwh sold by TVA as determined by TVA from its records exceeded or was less than 1.45 mills, respectively, during the most recently completed fiscal year ending with June 30.
- Under A, the customer's bill for each month will be increased or decreased by 0.03 mill per kwh for each 1 cent or major fraction thereof by which the sum of (a) TVA's interest charges to operations during the most recently completed fiscal year ending with June 30 and (b) the return on the appropriation investment that TVA is obligated to pay for the fiscal year immediately following said most recently completed fiscal year, divided by the sum of the monthly billing demands of power sold by TVA in said most recently completed fiscal year as determined by TVA from its records exceeded or was less than 40 cents, respectively.
- Under B and C, the customer's bill for each month will be increased or decreased by 1 cent per kw of billing demand for each 1 cent or major fraction thereof by which the sum of (a) TVA's interest charges to operations during the most recently completed fiscal year ending with June 30 and (b) the return on the

appropriation investment that TVA is obligated to pay for the fiscal year immediately following said most recently completed fiscal year, divided by the sum of the monthly billing demands of power sold by TVA in said most recently completed fiscal year as determined by TVA from its records exceeded or was less than 40 cents, respectively.

Any adjustment made pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2 or 3 shall be effective for 12 consecutive monthly billings beginning with the first bill rendered from meter readings taken after August 1 of the calendar year in which each such fiscal year ends.

Minimum Bill.

The monthly bill under A shall in no case be less than \$1.50. The monthly bill under B shall in no case be less than \$1.50 plus an additional \$0.50 per kilowatt for the excess over 50 kilowatts of the highest demand during the preceding 12 months. Under C, the monthly bill for demand, energy, and adjustments shall in no case be less than \$1.30 per kilowatt of the contract demand or any higher demand established during the preceding 12 months, but said \$1.30 shall be adjusted in the same manner as provided in Adjustment 3 above with respect to the customer's billing demand. Distributor may require minimum bills higher than those stated.

Seasonal Service.

Customers who contract for service on a seasonal basis shall be limited to 1,500 kw and shall pay the above rates plus 10 per cent of the bill computed after any adjustments are applied. For such customers the minimum monthly bill provided for above shall not apply. Instead, such customers shall pay a minimum monthly bill of \$5.00 as long as service is cut in, shall pay a minimum annual bill which shall in no case be less than (a) 2 cents per kilowatt hour of the maximum monthly consumption for customers whose demand does not exceed 50 kilowatts or (b) \$6.00 per kilowatt of the maximum demand established

for customers whose demand is over 50 kilowatts, and shall pay in addition the actual cost of cut-ins and cut-outs in excess of one of each per year.

Contract Requirement.

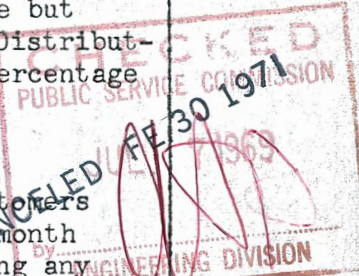
Distributor may require contracts for all service provided under this schedule. Customers whose demand exceeds 50 kilowatts will be required to execute contracts for an initial term of at least one year. If the customer requires in excess of 5,000 kilowatts, the contract shall be for an initial term of at least five years, and any renewal or extension of the initial contract shall also be for a term of at least five years. The customer shall contract for his maximum requirements and Distributor shall not be obligated to furnish power in greater amount at any time than the customer's contract demand. The contract with any customer may provide for minimum charges higher than those stated above. If the customer uses any power other than that supplied by Distributor under this rate, the contract may include other special provisions. The rate schedule in any power contract will be subject to modification at any time upon agreement by Distributor and TVA.

Surcharge.

Bills, including minimum bills and bills for seasonal service but excluding any rental charges for facilities, are subject to Distributor's surcharge. The surcharge will be based on a straight percentage of the bill computed after any adjustments are applied.

Determination of Demand.

Distributor will measure the demands in kilowatts of all customers having loads in excess of 50 kilowatts. The demand for any month shall be the highest average load measured in kilowatts during any 30 consecutive minute period of the month. However, if 85 percent of the highest average kva measured during any 30 consecutive minute

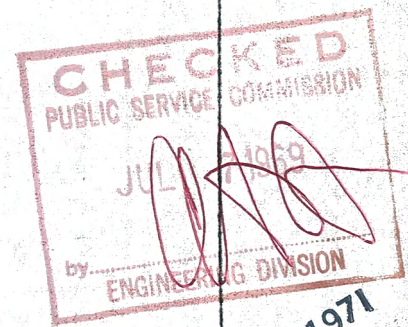
period for any load of 5,000 kva or less (or 85 percent of the first 5,000 kva plus 95 percent of the remainder of any load over 5,000 kva) is higher than the kw demand, such amount will be used as the billing demand.

Payment.

Above rates and charges are net. In the event that any bill is not paid within 10 days from date of bill, there shall be added to the bill an amount equal to 10 percent on the first \$250.00 of the bill plus one percent on any portion of the bill exceeding \$250.00. To any amount remaining unpaid 30 days after the date of the bill, there shall be added a penalty of one percent and an additional one percent shall be added at the end of each successive 30-day period until the amount is paid in full.

Single-Point Delivery.

The above rates and charges are based upon the supply of service through a single delivery and metering point, and at a single voltage. Separate supply for the same customer at other points or at different voltage shall be separately metered and billed.
