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## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rules and Regulations for the government of electric utilities, now established by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission are a part of the Rules and Regulations of the Company.

### APPLICATION

A copy of the rates and standard terms and conditions under which service is to be rendered to the Customer will be furnished upon application at the Company's office, and the Customer may elect upon which tariff his application shall be based. A written application may be required from each customer, which application when duly accepted by the Company shall constitute the agreement between the Company and Customer. A copy of the application will be furnished the Customer upon request.

### DEPOSIT

A deposit or a suitable guarantee may be required of the Customer before service will be supplied. The Company will pay interest on deposits, so made in accordance with statutory requirements. The Company shall have a reasonable time in which to read and remove the meters and to ascertain that the obligations of the Customer have been fully performed before being required to return any deposit.

### INSPECTION

The Company will connect its distribution system to the wiring of the Customer only when the following conditions are complied with: (1) After the delivery to the Company by the Customer of a certificate of inspection or notice of approval issued by a duly recognized authority, such as the National Board of Fire Underwriters or any underwriter's inspection bureau, or of an inspector delegated by the municipality, served by the Thacker Electric Light & Power Enterprise, Inc., such certificate being to the effect that the interior wiring of the premises of the Customer has been installed in accordance with the requirements of the National Board of Fire Underwriters, or as fixed by the municipality, or (2) In lieu of inspection certificate the delivery by the Customer to the Company of an agreement, duly signed by the owner and tenant of the premises, authorizing the connection to the interior

wiring in the premises and assuming all risk which may be incident thereto. Any changes in or additions to the original equipment of the Customer shall be subject to the requirement fixed above to insure a continuance of service. No responsibility is attached to the Company because of any waiver of these requirements.

USE OF ENERGY

It is expressly understood and agreed that electric service furnished to the Customer shall be for his (or their) own use and may not be remetered (sub-metered or resold) by the Customer to another or other consumers without the written consent of the Company.

SERVICE CONNECTIONS

When service is to be established the Company will locate its service connection and the Customer's wiring must be brought outside the building wall nearest the Company's service wires so as to readily accessible thereto and in such manner that all wiring furnished by the Company will be in plain view from the street or alley. The inside wiring must extend at least eighteen (18") inches beyond the building for the Company to attach its wires thereto.

All connections between the service entrance and the meter location must be installed in conduit in accordance with the requirements of the National Electric Code. All meters, service connections and other equipment furnished and installed by the Company on Customer's premises shall be and remain the Company's property.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

The main transmission lines of the Company or branches thereof, will be extended to such points as provide sufficient load to justify such extensions, or in lieu of sufficient load, the Company may require such definite written guarantees from a Customer or group of Customers, in addition to any minimum payments required by the tariff as may be necessary. This requirement may also be made by covering the repayment, within a reasonable time, of the cost of tapping such existing lines for light or power service or both.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

COMPANY'S LIABILITY

The Company will exercise the utmost diligence in furnishing a regular and uninterrupted supply of energy but in case such supply be interrupted or fail by reason of an act of God, the public enemy, accidents, strikes, legal process, State or Municipal interferences, break-downs or injury to the machinery or distributing lines of the Company or necessary extraordinary repairs, the Company shall not be liable for damages on account of such interruption or failure.

Company will not be liable for damages on account of death of or injury to any person or destruction of or injury to property arising from or caused by the furnishing of electric service maintenance of operation of any wiring, or any electrical equipment or fixture on the Customer's premises other than damages arising from or caused by the Company's wilful neglect or default. Customer shall indemnify and hold harmless Company from any and all such damages that is to reimburse Company upon its demand for any and such damages that may be recovered of it or that it may incur or is required to pay.

CUSTOMER'S LIABILITY

In the event of loss or injury of the property of the Company through misuse by, or the negligence of, the Customer or the employees of the same, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacement thereof shall be repaid to the Company by the Customer.

Customer will be held responsible for tampering, interfering with, or breaking of seals of meters, or other equipment of the Company installed on the Customer's premises, and will be held liable for same according to law. The Customer hereby agrees that no one except the employees of the Company shall be allowed to make any internal or external adjustments of any meter or any other piece of apparatus which shall be the property of the Company.

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COMPANY'S AUTHORIZATION FOR INGRESS OR EGRESS

The Company shall have the right at all reasonable hours to enter the premises of the Customer for the purpose

of installing, removing, testing, replacing or otherwise disposing of its apparatus and property, and the right of entire removal of the Company's property in the event of the termination of service for any cause.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

Whenever the supply of electricity is turned off for violation of rules and regulations, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of electricity, the Company may make a reconnection charge for restoring the service, payable in advance.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

The Company reserves the right to discontinue service to any Customer for violation of its rules and regulations but shall not do so without first having diligently tried to induce the Customer to comply with its rules and regulations. After such effort on the part of the Company, service will be discontinued only after at least twenty-four hours' written notice of such intention has been given to the Customer by the Company, provided, however, that where fraudulent use of electricity is detected, or where a dangerous condition is found to exist on the Customer's premises, the electricity will be cut off without such notice.

Any suspension of service shall not terminate the contract, between Company and Customer nor shall it abrogate any minimum charge which may be effective.

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE

The delayed payment charge will be effective for any current month regardless of prompt payment of bill, or bills, for said current month if any unpaid balance remains for electricity previously furnished.

COMMERCIAL COMBINED LIGHTING AND APPLIANCE SERVICE

Applicable in Kentucky opposite Rose Siding and Thacker  
West Virginia.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for commercial lighting and appliance  
service to any customer on the existing alternating current  
lines of the Company using 110 volt, 60 cycle, single phase  
service.

RATE

First	100 kilowatt hours used per month	10 cents per K. W. H.
Next	100 kilowatt hours used per month	8 cents per K. W. H.
Next	200 kilowatt hours used per month	6 cents per K. W. H.
All over	400 kilowatt hours used per month	5 cents per K. W. H.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The above schedule is subject to a minimum monthly  
charge of one dollar sixty cents (\$1.60) plus fifty cents  
(50¢) per horse power or fraction thereof.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid  
in full within ten (10) days of date of bill, five percent  
(5%), but not less than twenty-five cents (25¢), will be  
added to the net amount shown.

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SCHEDULE D L A

RESIDENTIAL COMBINED LIGHTING AND APPLIANCE SERVICE

Applicable in Kentucky opposite Rose Siding and Thacker,  
West Virginia.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for residential lighting and appliance  
service to any customer on the existing alternating current  
lines of the Company using 110 volt, 60 cycle, single  
phase service.

RATE

A monthly customer charge of fifty cents (50¢)  
per meter, plus an energy charge as follows:

First	25 kilowatt hours used per month	9.5¢ per K. W. H.
Next	75 kilowatt hours used per month	7.5¢ per K. W. H.
All over	100 kilowatt hours used per month	5.0¢ per K. W. H.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The above schedule is subject to a minimum monthly  
charge of one dollar sixty cents (\$1.60) net.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not  
paid in full within ten (10) days of date of bill, five  
percent (5%), but not less than twenty-five cents (25¢) will  
be added to the net amount shown.
