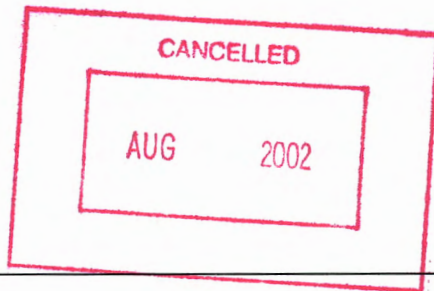

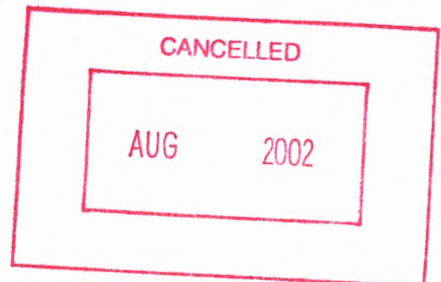

A delayed payment charge of 9% shall apply to all bills not paid within 20 days of the billing date. Penalties are assessed only once on a past due amount, and are not calculated on any amounts in arrears.	
<u>Purchase Gas Adjustment Clause</u>	
The above monthly rates are subject to the provisions of purchased gas adjustment clauses and may be adjusted from time to time as provided in said clause. (See attached)	
<u>Compound Interest on Customer Deposits</u>	
Belfry Gas, Inc. adopted a compound interest policy in response to Ky. Power Order No. 89-057. Customer deposits are compounded annually at a rate of 6% as of January 1, 1989 and interest will be computed and paid on a pro-rated basis for partial year deposits.

PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES

The rates authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of gas to the Applicant as computed upon rates of its wholesale suppliers then currently in effect under Federal Energy Regulatory Commission tariffs for interstate business or under wholesale tariffs of this Commission. For the purpose of this purchased gas adjustment clause, these rates shall be considered as the base rate for purchased gas. In the event there is an increase in this base rate the Applicant shall file with this Commission the following information:

(1) A copy of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission tariff or wholesale tariff of this Commission effecting the change in the base rate and a statement relative to the effective date of such proposed change.

(2) A statement setting out the details of gas purchased under the provision of the base rate for the previous twelve months showing billing under the base rate and under the proposed revised rate applicable to this service.

(3) A statement setting out the details of gas sold for the previous twelve months.

(4) A balance sheet as of the end of the latest twelve-month period and a statement of operating expenses and revenues in the same detail as reported to this Commission in the Utility's Annual Report.

(5) Such other information as this Commission may request for a proper determination of the purchased gas adjustment.

In the event there is a decrease in purchased gas costs or refund, the Applicant shall file the information required in 1, 2, and 4 above.

Upon receipt of this information, this Commission will review the effect of the revised rate on the operation of the Applicant and will issue its Order setting out the purchased gas adjustment that the Utility shall apply to its rates.

The maximum amount of the adjustment so prescribed shall not produce revenue adjustments based upon the actual preceding twelve-month period, greater than the difference between the purchased gas billed at the then existing rates and the purchased gas billed at the revised rate.

On and after the effective date of this rate schedule, if any increase or decrease is made in the rate at which Company's gas suppliers sell gas to the Company, the unit charges of the aforesaid rate schedule shall be increased or decreased by a Purchased Gas Adjustment determined as follows:

(1) Gas purchases will be determined by the Company under supplier's applicable rate schedule during a period of twelve calendar months ending within three months preceding the month of the effective date of the supplier's rate change. Such purchases shall be:

- (a) At the Base Supplier Rate
- (b) At the New Supplier Rate

(2) The difference between the amounts so determined shall be divided by the number of cubic feet of gas sold by the Company during the said twelve-month period, unless purchases is in excess of 105% of total sales. In such instance, said difference shall be divided by sales plus five (5) percent. The unit charge or credit so determined, expressed in cents per cubic foot, shall be the Purchased Gas Adjustment applicable to consumer billings.

(3) The new supplier rates shall become the Base Supplier Rate to be used in measuring the effect of any subsequent supplier rate change. Each such subsequent change shall be treated in the same manner as set forth above for the establishment of a new Purchased Gas Adjustment and for the establishment of a new Base Supplier Rate.

In the event that the Company receives from its supplier a refund of amounts paid to such supplier in respect of a prior period, the Company will apply to the Commission for authority and upon receipt thereof make adjustments on the amounts charged to its customers under this provision, as follows:

(1) The "Refundable Amount" shall be the amount received by the Company as a refund. Such Refundable Amount shall be divided by the number of cubic feet of gas that Company estimates it will sell to its customers during the four-month period commencing with the first day of the month following receipt of the refund, thus determining a "Refund Factor."

(2) Effective with meter readings taken on and after the first day of the second month following receipt of the refund, the Company will reduce by the Refund Factor so determined any Purchased Gas Adjustment that would otherwise be applicable during such period. Provided, however, that the period of reduced Purchased Gas Adjustment will be adjusted, if necessary, in order to refund as nearly as possible the Refundable Amount.

(3) In the event of any large or unusual refunds, the Company may apply to the Energy Regulatory Commission for the right to depart from the refund procedure herein set forth.

Deposit Requirements

The deposit requirements of new customers are as follows:

Meter deposit            \$50            (6% interest is paid on these deposits)

Meter Testing

The utility periodically selects customers meters for testing. Although no significant variations have been noted in the last, bill adjustments would be made as required in 807 KAR 50:015, Section 9.

Discontinuance of Service

The utility's operating procedures related to discontinuance of service are compatible with the regulations set out in 807 KAR 50:015 Section II.

Extension of Service

The utility's operating procedures related to extension of service are compatible with the rules and regulations as set out in 807 KAR 50:035 Section 9.

Meter Reading and Billing

Meters are ready every month, (around the 15th of each month), by experienced meter readers. The meter cards are processed by an outside computer service with the necessary accounting controls to assure proper billing. Bills are mailed to the customers on the 1st of each month and payments are due and payable by the 12th of each month.

Reconnection or Special Charges

The utility's operating policies related to any reconnection or other special charges will be cost supported and in conformity with 807 KAR 50:025 Section 5(2c).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Budget Billing Payment Plan

(A) Objective

To establish a procedure whereby residential customers may pay their gas bill in equal monthly installments.

(B) Availability

The plan will be available to all Belfry Gas customers who have received service at their present location for at least six months and have a present bill status as "current".

(C) Terms and Policy of the Plan

1. Plan Implementation:

The residential customers will be notified by letters mailed the last week of June 1980 that the plan is available. The customer will have until July 15, 1980 to respond to the notice as to their desire to participate in the plan.

Upon receipt of the customers request to participate, Belfry Gas will review the customers account as to its current status and if the customer's account is current the budget amount will be computed and the customer notified as to budget amount.

2. Computation of Budget Amount

For those customers who have a twelve month service history the budget amount will be computed by applying current rates to that twelve month usage, adding applicable taxes, and dividing that total by eleven.

For those customers who have less than a twelve month service history the current amount will be computed by applying the current rates to the average twelve month usage for all residential customers, adding applicable taxes, and dividing the total by eleven.

Budget amounts computed above will be rounded up to even dollars.

3. Contract Period

The contract period runs from August to July each year. The bill paid for July will close out the contract year and any credit remaining after the July bill will be carried over into the new contract year.

4. Delinquent Accounts

No customers with a past due balance will be eligible for the plan. Any customers implementing the budget plan that do not maintain a current status as to the budget payments will forfeit their right to participate, and the balance owed to that particular date will become payable immediately.


