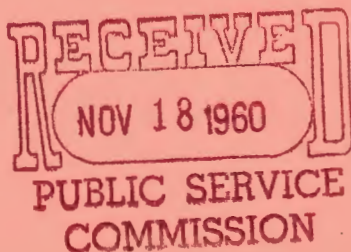

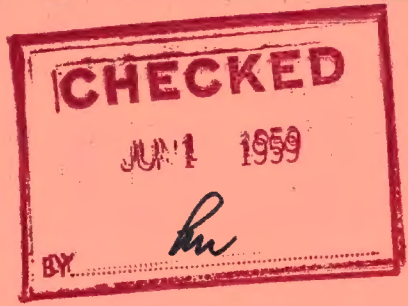

To obtain the MONTHLY BUDGET PAYMENT, the total gas consumption for a recent twelve month period is added together and divided by twelve months. 3. This MONTHLY BUDGET PAYMENT is charged each month for the budget year, regardless of the amount of gas actually used. 4. Adjustments are made at the end of the budget year for gas usage over the monthly budget payments, and credit issued to the customer for any payment over the actual consumption. 5. Late charges are not assessed on the budget plan; however, continuous payments after the due date may be cause for removal from the program. 6. The monthly budget bill will show: a. The amount of gas used and the charge for the actual consumption b. The monthly budget payment to be made c. A running balance of the difference between the amount used and amount paid (Escrow Account) 7. Although the first of twelve (12) budget payments is due with the June billing, customers may join the program at a later date by additional payment into their escrow account. 8. Prior to June of each year, each customer is advised of the availability of the Budget Program by advertising on the gas bill proper, in the newspaper and at each collection station.

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE</u></p> <p>Peoples Gas Company of Kentucky may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills.</p> <p>(1) If discontinuance is for nonpayment of bills, the customer shall be given at least ten (10) days written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty-seven (27) days after the mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may be effected not less than thirty (30) days from the date the utility notifies the customer, in writing, of state and federal programs which may be available to aid in payment of bills and the office to contact for such possible assistance. Termination notice shall include the following:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF UTILITY SERVICE</u></p> <p>Notice is hereby given that your service will be terminated on the date indicated on the enclosed notice in keeping with our policy for non-payment of your utility bill.</p> <p>Service will be terminated on the date indicated unless you deliver to this office or to the serviceman sent to terminate your service the total amount of your delinquent bill as shown on the enclosed notice. If you elect to pay the serviceman sent to terminate your service, a service call charge of \$15.00 will be added to the bill.</p> <p>You have the right to protest the discontinuance of this service by contacting the gas co. office at the address listed above. There will be on duty during the published hours of operation an employee to answer your questions regarding your bill or to resolve disputes over the amount of your bill.
