RULES AND REGULATIONS

RATE PER UNIT

A. The said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee, shall furnish, install, maintain, and operate a meter of a standard make and shall make all connections at the tapping-point on the gas lines owned and operated by him.

Materials required to make tap and installation:

B. The consumer shall furnish all necessary pipe and fittings to make the connections at the pipe line or well and shall furnish, install, maintain, and operate three regulators of a standard make installed in and maintained in a workmanship manner to be approved by the said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee, without and obligation on his part to inspect or approve the maintenance or installation.

Disrupted service to Consumer

C. The said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee, shall not be held liable because of failure to render service of gas to consumer because of the use of compressor stations, line breaks, forced well shut-in's, or any act of God thereby separating him from his source of gas. The said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee, shall not be held liable to furnish gas when it becomes necessary to abandon the existing wells and remove his pipe lines.

Damages caused by gas delivered to consumer:

D. The said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee, shall not be liable for damages caused by improper use, hazardous equipment, failure of regulators or any malpractice to the consumers property and the consumer expressly agrees after the gas passes into his lines it becomes his property.

E. If meters are not read monthly the minimum charges and rates shall be prorated over the metering period.

- .55 for each 1,000 cu. ft. of gas delivered thereafter each month.

Installation Charge:

A fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged for each connection made or approved by the said, W. W. Lindsey, Trustee.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be \$1.50.
