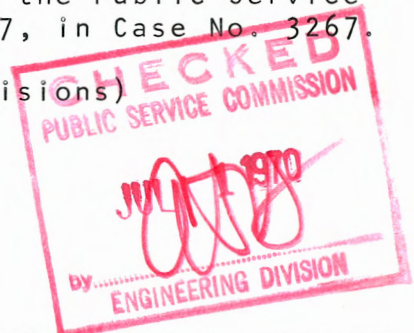

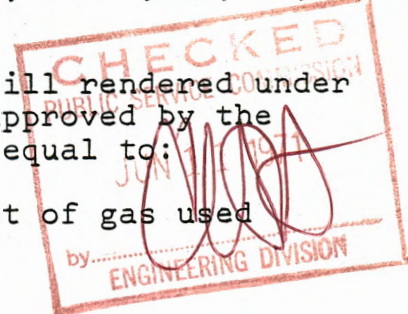

FOR CHANGES IN WHOLESALE COST OF NATURAL GAS

(4) A forecast showing the estimated gas purchases from all of the utilities contract suppliers for the next twelve months period together with an estimate of the cost thereof.

(5) Such other information as this Commission may request for a proper determination of the purchased gas adjustment.

Upon receipt of this information this Commission will review the effect of the revised base rate on the operations of the Applicant (Western Kentucky Gas Company) and will prior to the effective date of the revised base rate, but not less than thirty days from the date of the filing of the above prescribed information, issue its Order setting out the purchased gas adjustment that the utility shall apply to its rates and/or such refunds as may be proper.

The maximum amount of the adjustment so prescribed shall not produce revenue adjustments based upon the actual preceding twelve months period, greater than the difference between the purchased gas billed at the then existing rate and the purchased gas billed at the revised rate.
