RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by Green Hills Water District hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SERVICE AREA

The Utility furnishes water service to the Bledsoe community, Routes 221 and 421 and Dark Hollow Road located in the northwestern section of Harlan County, Kentucky.

AVAILABILITY

Water service is available to any domestic, commercial or industrial consumer within the District's service area.

WATER FAILURE

The Utility is responsible for water failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the Utility or its employees.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend water service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the consumer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066~~1~~, Section 12.

LINE RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the first day of each month and will be due and payable within 10 days. A 10% late payment penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The rates or charges aforesaid shall be billed monthly, on statements which shall be issued on or about the first of each month, and all bills for such service shall be considered due and payable ten days after the date of issue. If a bill is not paid within ten days after such date of issue, such bill shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid, in an amount equal to ten percent of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of such delinquent bill. When a bill has been delinquent for twenty days, the District shall serve a customer written notice of his delinquency and of the fact that such customer is entitled, upon written request, to a hearing on the question of termination of service. If such bill is not paid within ten days after the mailing of such notice, and if no hearing is requested, or if a hearing is requested and timely held, and such customer's delinquency is thereby established, the District may disconnect the water service of such customer without further notice, subject to the provisions of the By-Laws, Rules, and Regulations.

SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGE

A charge of \$15.00 shall be made for all service reconnection made during regular working hours.

DELINQUENT SERVICE CHARGE

If service was disconnected due to an delinquent account, a reconnection charge of \$25.00 will be charged if reconnection is made during regular working hours.

METER READING RECHECK CHARGE

A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.

METER TEST REQUEST

Upon request and payment of 10.00, a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast, a refund of the 10.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly.

SERVICE INVESTIGATION CHARGE

A charge of \$10.00 per trip shall be made for service investigation during regular working hours if interruption of service is not caused by failure of the Commission's facilities. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond Commission's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.

CONTRIBUTION IN AID OF CONSTRUCTION

The established contribution fee is based on the size of service connection equipment/facilities required as noted : Water Service \$375.00
In addition to the above connection fees, service taps for other than residential, commercial/industrial use, shall be at cost. The customer shall pay the cost of installing all service line road bores or open cuts.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

A. Application for Service Connection

1. Applicants who desire service connection are required to come to the District office, pay the service connection installation fee, and sign a Water User Agreement prior to the time installation is desired.
2. Applicants for a service connection must furnish the District with the following information:
 - a) Name and mailing address of applicant,
 - b) Area in which service is to be located,

B. Service Line Inspection

1. All service lines, plumbing and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer. Service lines beyond the delivery point should be installed according to the following requirements:
 - a) Type of pipe 200 psi PVC
 - b) Size of pipe 3/4 "
 - c) Line buried 30 " deep
 - d) Cut-off valve on customer side of meter
 - e) Check valve on customer side of meter
 - f) No cross-connections

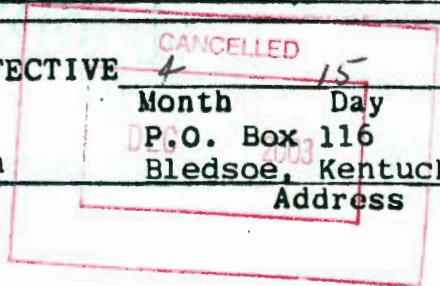

C. Miscellaneous

1. Customer agrees to comply with Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the Supplier.
2. The Supplier may shut off water service to customer for:
 - a) Non payment of bills
 - b) Customer allows a connection or extention to be made to his service line for the purpose of supplying water to another party.
 - c) Tampering with District meters
 - d) Failure to comply with District rules and regulations.
 - e) When a dangerous condition is found to exist.
3. Customers who obtain a service connection from the District but fail to run service lines to such connection will nevertheless be billed at the minimum rate. Failure to pay such bills will result in the customer Water Service Contract being placed in the District's default file. Future service will not be rendered until all such past due bills are paid.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.
3. If the annual usages differ by 10% percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.
5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
6. The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the Company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading or billing processes or customer inquiry.

WATER USER AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into between _____

whose address is _____,
hereinafter called "USER," and the Green Hills Water District,
P.O. Box 116 Bledsoe, Kentucky, hereinafter called "SUPPLIER."

WHEREAS, the USER desires to purchase water from the SUPPLIER, the USER hereby enters into this water user's agreement as required by the Bylaws of the SUPPLIER.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

The SUPPLIER shall furnish, subject to the limitations set out in it's Bylaws, Rules and Regulations now in force or as hereafter amended, such quantity of water as the USER may desire in connection with the property to be served is a Residence ____, Mobile Home ____ Other ____, located at _____.

The USER shall install and maintain, at his own expense, a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The location of the water on the property will be determined by the SUPPLIER. The SUPPLIER shall purchase and install a cutoff valve and water meter. The SUPPLIER shall have exclusive right to use such cutoff valve and water meter.

The USER agrees to pay a connection fee of \$375.00 to the SUPPLIER at the time this agreement is signed.

The USER agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the SUPPLIER, now in force or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed. The USER agrees to pay for water at such rates, time and place as shall be determined by the SUPPLIER, and agrees to the imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the SUPPLIER'S Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, or which have been or hereafter be adopted and imposed by the SUPPLIER.

The SUPPLIER shall determine the allocation of water to the USER in the event of a water shortage, and may shut off water to the USER if he allows a connection or extension to be made of his service line for the purpose of supplying water to another party. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the needs of the users, or in the event there is a shortage of water, the SUPPLIER may prorate the water available among the users on such basis as is deemed equitable by the GOVERNING BODY OF KENTUCKY and if at any time the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the need of all the users, the SUPPLIER must first satisfy all of the needs of all of the users for domestic purposes before supplying any water for livestock purposes and must satisfy all the needs for all users for both domestic and livestock purposes before supplying any water for garden purposes.

The USER agrees that no present or future source of water will be connected to any water lines served by the SUPPLIER'S water lines and will disconnect from his present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the SUPPLIER'S system and shall eliminate present or future cross-connections in his system.

The failure of the USER to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

1. Nonpayment within ten days from the due date will be subject to a penalty of ten percent of the delinquent account.
2. Nonpayment within thirty days from the due date will result in the water being shut off from the USER'S property.
3. In the event it becomes necessary for the SUPPLIER to shut off the water from the USER'S property, a fee of \$25.00 will be charge for the reconnection of service.

It is understood and agreed that the SUPPLIER reserves the right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply water to the USER. A 5/8-inch by 3/4-inch meter will be used unless the USER contracts for a larger meter. A separate meter must be installed for each residence. A separate contract will be used by trailer parks when trailers are not supplied by individual meters.

The USER agrees to permit the SUPPLIER to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at the point on USER'S property to be designated by the SUPPLIER for each signed connection with right to ingress and egress for these purposes over the USER'S property, and to grant easement for installation of water lines where required.
