RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL

1. **COMMISSION'S RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

All water service rendered by the Company shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky and all amendments thereto.

2. **COMPANY'S RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

In addition to the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the Commission, all water service rendered shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Company as filed with the Public Service Commission.

3. **APPLICATION FOR SERVICE:**

All applications for service shall be made on the Company's standard application and shall be signed by the customer, or his duly authorized agent, and accepted by the Company before any service is rendered.

A separate application shall be made for each class of service at each separate location.

In cases where unusual construction or equipment expense is necessary to furnish the service, the Company may require a contract for a minimum period of one (1) year.

4. **OWNER'S CONSENT TO OCCUPY:**

In case the customer is not the owner of the premises or of the intervening property between the premises and the company's

service connection, it shall be the customer's responsibility to obtain from the property owner or owners, the necessary consent to install and maintain in, on or over, said premises all such piping and other equipment necessary for supplying water service to the customer whether the piping and equipment be the property of the customer or the Company.

5. SECURITY DEPOSITS:

The Company may require from all customers a cash security deposit of an amount equal to two-twelfths of the estimated annual bill for such customer. Such deposit less unpaid amounts for service rendered the customer shall be returned upon the discontinuance of service.

6. ACCESS TO PREMISES:

The Company shall have the right of access to the customer's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of installing, reading, inspecting, repairing, or removing its meters, and other equipment used in connection with the supply of water, or for the purpose of turning on or off the water supply when necessary for all proper purposes.

7. COMPANY'S EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION:

The Company shall furnish, install and maintain at its expense, service connection extending from its mains to the customer's nearest curb or property line. The location of this service connection will be made at the discretion and judgment of the Company.

The Company will furnish, install and maintain at its expense the necessary meter, shut-off valve and meter vault which will be located at the discretion or judgment of the Company. Suitable site for the location for the meter, shut-off valve and meter vault and other such connections shall be provided by the customer,

and the title to this equipment shall remain in the Company with the right to install, operate, maintain and remove same and no charge shall be made by the customer for the use of the premises as occupied or used.

8. CUSTOMER'S EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION:

The customer shall furnish, install and maintain at his expense the necessary customer service line extending from the Company's service connection at the curb or property line to the building or place of utilization of the water.

Installation of the customer service line shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission and Department of Health for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and the Company specifications. The location of the service line shall be the point of easiest access to the Company from its facilities, and the Company shall be consulted and its approval obtained before installation is made.

All service lines shall be maintained by the customer at his expense in a good, safe and servicable condition. The Company shall not assume any responsibility and shall not be held liable in any way for the making of periodic inspections of the customer's service line.

9. METERING:

The water consumed shall be measured by a meter to be installed by the Company upon the customer's premises at a point most accessible or convenient for the Company and all bills shall be calculated upon the registration of the meter.

In multi-family dwellings each such dwelling unit shall be metered separately if at all practical.

10. PROTECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY:

All meters, piping and other equipment furnished by the Company, which may be at any time in or on the customer's premises shall be and remain the property of the Company, and the customer shall protect such property from loss or damage and no one who is not an agent or employee of the Company shall be permitted to remove or tamper with such property.

11. EXCLUSIVE SERVICE:

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the State Department of Health and of this Rule by the Company, no customer shall permit the co-mingling of water with that provided by the Company by means of an inter-connection with such other source or supply to the customer's interior plumbing.

The customer shall not sell water purchased from the Company to any other customer, Company or person, and the customer shall not deliver water purchased from the Company to or through any connection wherein said water is to be used off the customer's premises.

12. POINT OF DELIVERY:

The point of delivery of water supplied by the Company shall be at the point the water passes from the pipes of the Company's service connection into the customer's service line, or on the discharge side of the meter, whichever is nearest the delivery main of the Company.

13. MONTHLY BILLS:

Bills for water service will be rendered monthly unless

otherwise specified. The term "month" for billing purposes shall mean the period between the first working day of each month, or between any two consecutive readings of the meter by the Company, such readings to be taken on the first working day of each month or as soon thereafter as practicable.

Bills are due upon the rendition thereof and shall be payable within a period not exceeding 10 days.

Service shall be subject to being discontinued if bills are not paid in full within fifteen (15) days after the rendition thereof but only after forty-eight (48) hour notice to the customer.

Failure to receive a bill does not exempt a customer from these provisions.

When the Company is unable to read the meter after a reasonable effort or where the meter fails to operate, the customer will be billed on an estimated basis at the average of the three immediately preceding months and the billing adjusted as necessary when the meter is read.

14. CUSTOMER'S DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE:

Any customer desiring service discontinued or changed from one location to another shall give the Company three (3) days advance notice in person, by phone or in writing. The customer shall be held responsible for all water consumed until such notice is received by the Company and three (3) days time allowed to read the meter and render the final bill.

15. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR CAUSE:

The Company has the right to discontinue service to a customer for violation of its Rules and Regulations or for

non-payment of bills, or where the customer is co-mingling in his interior plumbing and fixtures, water from another source with that purchased from the Company.

(N)

Neglect or refusal on the part of the customer to provide reasonable access to the premises for the purpose of reading meters, inspection, maintenance and operation of the Company's facilities shall be deemed sufficient cause for discontinuance of service, but only upon at least Forty Eight (48) Hours notice to the customer.

16. RECONNECTION CHARGE:

A reconnection charge will be made by the Company to cover the cost incurred in reconnecting a customer when (a) The customer's service has been discontinued for non-payment of bills or for a violation of the Rules and Regulations, and the customer has qualified for and requested the service to be reconnected or, (b) The customer's service has been disconnected at his request and is reconnected at the same or other premises.

The reconnection charge provided for in the Company's rate schedule shall be paid by the customer before or at the time the service is reconnected.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) No customer is to give away or sell water.
- 2) Customers are excused from water bill upon notification to the Company that they wish to disconnect.
- 3) Any damage to the Company's mains made by the customer's installation of service line is to be the responsibility of the customer.
- 4) Each customer is responsible for the maintenance and repair of his service line.
- 5) Connection to the Company's mains can only be made by first notifying the Company.
- 6) Bills will be paid within 30 days of receipt.
- 7) The reconnection charge shall be \$8.00.
- 8) Customers shall not let water run continuously from their faucets to prevent line freezing but shall adequately insulate their plumbing.
- 9) Apartment houses or multifamily dwellings shall pay the regular bill for each family.
- 10) No customer shall connect to a well, cistern, or other source of water while he is connected to the Company System.
