RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Utility Regulatory Commission.
2. Any resident or business of Lone Oak Water District is eligible for water service from the District, provided a water main is within one hundred feet of the applicant's property line.
3. If the property line is not within one hundred feet of a water main, the applicant may, at his own expense, install the main extensions according to the District's Rules and Regulations and the requirements of the Utility Regulatory Commission. On approval of the Board of Commissioners, such extension may be made by the District in accordance with 807 KAR 25:050, Section 12.
4. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receipt of a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance.
5. All applicants for service shall sign a Consumer Application card. No deposit is required.
6. The customer shall be responsible for all plumbing installed on his property, beginning at the outlet side of the meter. Installation shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources and Environmental Protection.
7. All services shall be metered.
8. No connections to the water pipes of the District shall be made except by or under the supervision of a duly authorized officer, agent, or employee of the District.
9. All distribution mains, service lines, and service connections shall be governed by the provisions of 807 KAR 25:050, Sections 9, 10, and 13. In addition:
 - (A) Main extensions shall be installed by the Water District's forces, or by a competent contractor employed either by the District or by the person or persons desiring service, said contractor to be acceptable to the District.
 - (B) Plans and specifications for proposed extensions shall be prepared by a professional engineer and shall be submitted to the District for approval. Said plans and specifications shall comply with the District's standards and shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources and Environmental Protection, the Utility Regulatory Commission, and other applicable federal, state, and local regulating agencies.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- (C) Water mains shall generally be laid in a fifteen foot permanent easement on private property. A fifteen foot temporary construction easement adjacent to the permanent easement shall also be required, where practical, from each private property owner.
- (D) Meters, meter boxes, and service lines from the main to the meter will be installed by the District, as required, to customers adjacent to said main extensions, and the District shall be reimbursed for this service by the property owner in the form of a meter-setting fee current at the time the service is rendered.
- (E) After the mains have been installed, tested, and disinfected to the satisfaction of the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources, the District shall then accept responsibility for furnishing potable water to the extension and for maintenance of the lines, including meters, meter boxes, and service lines from the main to the meter. Extensions not constructed by the District's forces shall be subject to a one-year guarantee period before the District will accept responsibility for maintenance.
- (F) Rates for furnishing water shall be the current rates in effect for the District as approved by the Utility Regulatory Commission.

- 10. Term of all services is on a monthly basis. Meters are read monthly, and bills are mailed by the 1st of the month.
- 11. A ten per cent penalty is added to any bill not paid by the 19th of the month.
- 12. The District will not accept partial payment of a bill. To maintain service, each bill shall be paid in full, including charges for water service, sewer service if applicable, and any applicable taxes.
- 13. On the first of the month notices are mailed to consumers whose bills remain unpaid, stating that service will be discontinued on the 9th or 10th if the bill is not paid by the 9th of the next month after the original bill was mailed. *
- 14. If the water service of any customer is discontinued for nonpayment of bills, the District shall require payment of \$10.00 reconnection fee and payment of all delinquent bills in full, including penalties, before reconnection is made. If the meter has been removed because of fraudulent or illegal use of water after discontinuance of service, a fee of \$15.00 shall be charged for re-establishing service.

* Exceptions shall be made in cases of illness or infirmity, in accordance with 807 KAR 25:020, Section 11 (2) (a).

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident of Lone Oak Water District is eligible for water service from the district.
3. Water service will be terminated immediately upon request from the customer requesting discontinuance.
4. All applications for service shall sign a Consumers Application Card. No deposit required.
5. Meters are read monthly. All bills are due and payable on the 8th of the month.
6. A 10% collection charge is added if not paid on or before the 18th of the month.
7. Notices are sent to consumers whose bill remains unpaid on the first of the following month from date of bill stating the date services will be discontinued.
8. Services are discontinued on all unpaid bills on the 9th or 10th of the month.
9. To reconnect, the consumer must pay the bill plus a \$1.00 service charge.
10. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a meter setting fee (N)(C) in the following amounts:
 - For a 5/8" X 3/4" Meter - \$275.00
 - 3/4" Meter - \$325.00
 - 1 " Meter - \$400.00
 - 1-1/2" Meter - \$650.00
 - 2 " Meter - \$825.00

RULES AND REGULATIONS

11. The consumer installs the line from the meter to the building at his own expense.
12. Upon a request from the consumer the meter will be brought in to the shop and tested; if the test proves the meter to be within 2% of perfect, either fast or slow, a consumer is charged \$3.00. If not, necessary adjustments are made.
13. Anyone who desires service from the District and whose property is not adjacent to a water main can, at his own expense, install the main and fittings, according to the District specifications.
