RE: Murray Water District Number One

Dear Mr. Thomas:

In accordance with paragraph ten (10) of the original contract between Water District Number One and the City of Murray, Kentucky, that states "the water rates may be changed by agreement between the parties," the City of Murray requests that the rates be changed as follows:

CURRENT RATE

- A. For the first 300,000 gallons per month, 45¢ per 1,000 gallons; minimum bill \$135.00.
- B. All water in excess of 300,000 gallons per month, 35¢ per 1,000 gallons.

NEW RATE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 1978:

All water, 45¢ per 1,000 gallons; minimum bill \$135.00

This rate change reflects the increase that the Murray Common Council voted for all Water District customers in March, 1978. The change in rates is necessary due to increased power and water treatment costs, and compliance with more complex and stringent water quality regulations.

We would appreciate your discussion of this matter with your board and advise us accordingly of your concurrence.
