RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are intended to supplement all bond resolutions and by-laws which have been enacted by the district, and which are incorporated by reference.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 24th of each month.

2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the 1st of each month. Bills will state that they are to be paid within 10 days. However, provisions contained in the rate resolution as to penalties, cut-offs and meter deposits will apply, and the district may terminate service for failure to pay water bill. All meters will be located on district mains as specified in Engineer's specifications on the property to be served.

3. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and his decisions may be appealed to the district commission within 10 days.

4. The principal place of business of the district will be Spears, Kentucky, on Tates Creek Road, Route 5, Lexington, Kentucky, Jessamine County.

5. Water bills may be paid at District office at Spears, Kentucky, R. 5, Lexington, Kentucky.

6. In addition to standard connection fees, the district can require any developer of more than 1 lot (subdivider) or potential large user to furnish storage or pumping facilities or to enlarge supply lines or to guarantee payment of a minimum bill over a period of years by special contract.

7. The customer cannot give away or resell water without the written consent of the district.

8. Each house must be metered separately unless the written consent of the district to do otherwise is obtained.

9. Regulatory provisions of the rate resolutions, bylaws, if any, and bond ordinances are made a part of this rate resolution, together with standard customer contract and subdivision contract provisions.

Rules And Regulations

10. No residence shall be served through a field connection, meter shall be pulled and an installation fee will be charged at disclosure of such action.

11. The district does not guarantee either pressure or flow on any fire hydrant nor the working condition of any such fire hydrant. The hydrant is installed merely as a convenience for the purpose of serving as a reloading station for fire fighting equipment. No one shall use any fire hydrant for any purpose other than fire fighting use.

12. The district will permit main line extensions, storage and pumps paid for by customer, when in the judgment of the district's engineer there is sufficient pressure and volume for such extensions. Refunding agreements based on a refund of a portion of water bills and/or connection fees in excess of meter and installation costs over a period of 10 years can be established to pay up to all extension costs advanced by the customer including district administrative and professional charges billed the customer.

13. Nothing herein contained shall interfere with the extension of a system by issuance of additional bonds or supplemental bond issues.

14. At any time after the 10 year period set by bonding company, a private corporation may be formed by the members of the district, or any interested parties at the discretion of the board of commission. Customers will be refunded whatever equity each may have in said district for meter fees and installation charges, if any, and water bills paid over the years up to the time of corporation. Water rates shall be reduced from time to time as the commission deems feasible.

15. These rules may be amended by the District Commission.

By ORDER of the Public Service Commission September 20, 1968, effective November 1, 1968. The rates for water service rendered by the Spears Water District in the territory as set forth in the Jessamine & Fayette County Court Orders creating the Spears Water District shall be as follows:

Residence or Farm Connection

First	2,000 Gallons of Water Per Mo.	(Minimum Bill)	\$7.50
Next	10,000 Gallons of Water Per Mo.	Per 1,000 Gallons	2.00
All Over	12,000 Gallons of Water Per Mo.	Per 1,000 Gallons	1.00

Field Connections

First	1,000 Gallons	(Minimum Bill)	3.50
All Over	1,000 Gallons	Per 1,000 Gallons	1.00

Connection fees for above connections: \$ 200.00 per Connection plus cost of meter and installation to the extent that said meter and installation charge exceeds the actual cost of meter and installation.
