4.02 At the company's option, bills may be rendered monthly or bi-monthly. If the bills are rendered on a bi-monthly basis, the minimum monthly charge and allowable use of water shown on the Schedule of Minimum Monthly Bill, and the Gallons of water shown in the Schedule of Commodity Charges, and the monthly charge in the Schedule of Fire Service Charges will be multiplied by two.

4.03 In the event that payment for any charge is not made within twenty (20) days from the billing date, which is the due date, the net amount of the bill shall be increased by 10% and the gross amount thus determined must be paid.

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
