7.00 PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

7.01 Definitions

(a) "Base rate" for the purposes of this Part shall mean the wholesale cost of water of West Oldham Utilities, Inc., pursuant to valid contracts or wholesale tariffs on file with the Public Service Commission.

(b) "Changed rate" for the purposes of this Part shall mean an increase or decrease in the base rate until approved by the Public Service Commission pursuant to Section 7.02 at which time it shall become the base rate.

7.02 In the event that the wholesale supplier of water to West Oldham Utilities, Inc. initiates a changed rate in the base rate, then West Oldham Utilities shall file with the Public Service Commission the following information:

(a) A copy of the wholesale supplier's tariff effecting a change in the base rate and a statement from the wholesale supplier evidencing the effective date of the changed rate;

(b) A detailed statement of water purchased under the base rate for a twelve (12) month period ending within ninety (90) days of the filing date and showing billing both under such base rate and also under the changed rate;

(c) A detailed statement of water sold for the same twelve (12) month period;

7.04 If a change is made in a base rate charge to West Oldham Utilities, Inc. by its supplier(s), the unit charges of the wholesale tariff, established by Section 6.02, shall be increased or decreased by a purchased water adjustment calculated as follows:

(1) Water purchases shall be computed at the supplier's base rate and the supplier's changed rate using a period of twelve (12) calendar months ending within ninety (90) days preceding the month of the effective date of the supplier's rate change. The difference between these amounts shows the total change in the purchased water costs of West Oldham Utilities, Inc.

(2) The total change in purchased water costs shall be divided by the actual number of cubic feet or gallons sold, yielding the purchased water adjustment expressed in cents per cubic feet or gallons, unless the water loss of West Oldham Utilities, Inc. is calculated to exceed fifteen (15) percent.

(3) In instances where it is determined that the water loss exceeds fifteen (15) percent, the actual water sales shall be divided by eighty-five (85) percent yielding the maximum allowable water purchases. The maximum allowable water purchases shall then be multiplied by the change in cost per cubic foot or gallons, yielding the total allowable change. The total allowable change shall then be divided by the actual number of cubic feet or gallons sold, yielding the purchased water adjustment expressed in cents per cubic feet or gallons.

7.05 In the event West Oldham Utilities, Inc. receives a refund from its supplier for amounts previously paid, it shall immediately apply to the Public Service Commission for authority to make adjustments on the amounts charged customers' bills under this tariff as follows:

(1) The total refund received by West Oldham Utilities, Inc. shall be divided by the number of cubic feet or gallons of water which it estimates it will sell to its customers during the two (2) month period beginning with the first day of the month following receipt of the refund, yielding the refund factor to be applied against each cubic foot of water sold thereafter.

(2) Effective with meter readings taken on and after the first day of the second month following receipt of the refund, West Oldham Utilities, Inc. will reduce by the refund factor any purchased water adjustment that would otherwise be applicable during the period. The period of reduced purchased water adjustment shall be adjusted, if necessary, in order to most nearly approximate the total amount to be refunded. WATER SERVICES AND METERS

Application and Payment for Water Service

1.01 Upon proper application for its service to be installed West Oldham Utilities, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "WOU" shall furnish and install that portion of the service line from its main to the customer's property line including the curb stop and meter vault in accordance with 807 KAR 25:050, Section 14(3)(a).

The meter shall be located at or near the customer's property line. WOU shall own and maintain such facilities and have exclusive control thereof. The customer shall furnish and install the necessary pipe from the property line to the place of consumption and shall be responsible for the maintenance of same. The customer's service piping shall be at least one size larger than the service. WOU may require an applicant to render a deposit. The amount of the deposit shall be determined by WOU from time to time; provided, however, that the amount of the said deposit shall not exceed 3/12 of the estimated annual bill of such applicant. The deposit will be made at time of application.

Temporary Service

1.02 Temporary services, such as meters temporarily installed on fire hydrants, will be granted only on the payment of a deposit covering the cost of the meter and the fittings. This deposit will be refunded upon the return of the meter and fittings in good order, the payment of any damages that might have resulted to WOU's property from the use of such temporary service, and the payment of all charges for the consumption of water registered by the meter and billed at the applicable rate. Any damage to fire hydrants resulting from the use of such temporary service shall be paid by the customer using the same.

Method of Installing Services

1.03 Unless specifically provided for by other pertinent rules, only one service shall be installed into a premise. The service shall be installed perpendicular to WOU's main in the street or roadway on which the premise abuts.

Qualifications for Service Application

1.04 When requested by WOU, applications for service attachments to distribution pipes must be made by the owner of the premise to be served or by his duly authorized agent. When requested by WOU, the applicant must, as a requisite for the granting of the application, state fully and truly all purposes for which the water is requested, and sign a required application for such service connection.

Size of Service Attachments

1.05 The minimum size service pipe installed shall be three-fourths (3/4) inch diameter of water way. Larger sizes shall be installed as determined by WOU according to the quantity of water required in a specified period of time.

Responsibility for Location of Meter

1.06 The water service pipe and meter installed shall be located at the option of WOU. The location shall be designated by a stake marked with a line showing one (1) foot above ground level placed by the applicant. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to maintain the stake at the proper location until the service pipe and meter vault are installed. The WOU reserves the right to refuse to install the service pipe and vault if this stake is not present. The cost of relocation of service pipes and vaults, due to improper location of stake, shall be paid by the applicant.

Multiple Unit Premises

1.07 In supplying water to tenement houses, block buildings, apartment houses, and buildings or premises constructed and arranged in similar manner, and occupied by a number of tenants, one service pipe only will be installed for each building, and the owner of such building or premises, or his authorized agent, will be responsible for the payment of water used.

Foreign Supplies

1.08 The water from the WOU system shall not be supplied to any premises where the pipes used to convey or distribute water from the WOU's system are so connected, either directly or indirectly, as to receive a possible water supply from any source other than that furnished by WOU; or if the customer's piping and attached fixtures are so constructed that they may, in the opinion of the WOU, create a hazard from a sanitary standpoint, or may result in an unnecessary waste of water.

Dual Supplies

1.09 Whenever any direct or indirect physical connection, not specifically approved by the Board of Health, is found to exist, or to be liable to exist, between any private water system and WOU's system, the WOU's supply will be shut off from the premises forthwith. Provision for a removable nipple or a check valve will be considered a physical connection and does not meet the requirements contained herein. Except that where dual supplies are necessary and are approved by the Board of Health, the line serving water from the WOU system must be protected by an atmospheric gap of not less than six (6) inches from the possibility of water of the other system entering WOU's line.

Meter Measurement Required of All Water Supplied

1.10 All water supplied by the WOU shall be measured by meters installed and maintained by WOU for that purpose. No bypass between the meter and the distribution pipes shall be made or allowed to exist.

Location of Water Meter

1.11 Meters shall be generally installed in vaults located as near as possible to the customer's property line. Owner or consumer shall keep area around meter vault unobstructed.

Where it is necessary to install a meter within a customer's premises, ample and suitable space, free from exposure to frost, shall be furnished the WOU by the owner of such premises wherein to set, read, and repair the meter. This space at all times shall be accessible to the WOU employees, and access to which the meter consumer or owner of the premises shall keep unobstructed.

Branch Services

1.12 Only one building shall be supplied with water from each attachment, unless the buildings to be supplied with water are on one lot and owned by one person, who shall be responsible for all water bills. However, separate service connections will be required for adjacent buildings owned by one person and leased to separate tenants in order that each tenant may be responsible for his own water bill, provided that each house abuts on a street in which the WOU has a distribution main. This rule shall not be construed to mean that individual service connections will be installed for tenants occupying premises above the ground floor.

Owner's Liability

1.13 All risks attending the introduction of water supplies into basements or premises where pipes or conduits have been installed by or are under the control of the owner, tenant, occupant, or user of such water supply shall be assumed by such owner, tenant, occupant or user thereof.

Boilers and Pumps

1.14 Steam boilers shall not take a supply of water directly from the service pipe and depend upon the hydrostatic pressure in the water pipes to them under working pressure. Boiler feed pumps, injectors, inspirators, etc., shall not be connected directly with the service pipe, but shall have an intervening vessel in which to receive water from which to supply the boilers.

Heating Boilers and Water Heaters

1.15 House boilers and water heaters for domestic use must in all cases be provided with vacuum valves to prevent their collapse should a vacuum occur in the WOU distribution system. The WOU will, in no case, be responsible for accidents or damage resulting from the imperfect action of any such valves, from insecure boilers, or from variations in the water pressure.

Booster Pump Installations

1.16 Unless otherwise specifically authorized by the WOU consumers will not be permitted to install pumps that take water directly from the service pipes, but must have an intervening vessels into which to receive water from which it may be pumped.

Fountains, Swimming Pools and Aquariums

1.17 Fountains, swimming pools and aquariums must be so constructed that the water inlet in all installations shall be at least six (6) inches above the overflow or outlet pipe.

Plumbers Licenses and Instructions

1.18 Only plumbers licensed under the laws of the State of Kentucky, Counties of Oldham or Jefferson, or City of Louisville, shall install pipes and fixtures or make connections to or make repairs to facilities of water consumers of the WOU and then only in accordance to the rules and regulations of said WOU. In all cases, plumbers must leave the water turned off, or on, as they find it, in any service attachment upon or to which they attach, repair, or remove fixtures unless otherwise directed by the WOU. In no case shall an "off" service be left "on" without giving due notice to the WOU.

quantity of water for any purpose whatever, but simply an ample quantity for the purposes intended. The WOU does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of water for any purpose, but a supply as free from interruptions as is practicable, with the repairs, alterations, additions, and accidents attending a public water supply.

Customer's Control Valve

1.20 Water consumers, tenants, or owners of premises into which service pipes have been introduced or laid are forbidden to use the WOU stopcocks and valves. There shall be a stopcock placed by and at the expense of the property owner, tenant or water consumer, in every service attachment and shall be located at the first suitable point beyond the street limits. This stopcock is to enable the owner, tenant or consumer to turn off the water in case of accident to the pipes or water fixtures on the premises.

Owner's Liability for WOU Installations

1.21 The owner, occupant, tenant, or water consumer, jointly and severally, assume the risk of damages by water from water pipes and fixtures inside of their premises. Where the space from the curb line to the property line has been appropriated to private use, the piping fixtures and water conveyed therein, and any damage occasioned thereby, become the liability of such owner, occupant, tenant, or water consumer.

Re-Sale of Water

1.22 Water consumers shall not sell water or make use of it in any way that might be in conflict with the WOU's interest.

terminate such service. Failure to so notify the WOU will not relieve the consumer of the responsibility for charges for water used through such service.

Discontinuance of Service; Notification

1.231 When consumer desires discontinuance of water as in 1.23, consumer will give WOU 72 hours prior notice to turn off or transfer service.

Owner's Responsibility for Leaks

1.24 All owners of premises, tenants, or water consumers entitled to the use of water shall keep their service pipes, stopcocks and other apparatus in good repair and shall prevent all unnecessary waste of water.

WOU Responsibility for Leaks

1.25 The WOU will repair leaks in its own pipes and pipe joints only.

Water Bills

1.26 Water bills are due monthly or bi-monthly on the date shown on the bill, or as the WOU may hereafter designate. If any party shall refuse or neglect to pay the water bill by the due date indicated, then the gross amount of said bill as determined by the provisions of the applicable section of the Rate Schedule of Part III of the WOU Rules and Regulations shall be immediately due and payable.

1.27 Not less than two (2) days after the due date, any customer who has failed to pay the amount due shall be mailed a notice stating that the account is overdue, and setting forth a day, not less than three (3) days after the date of the notice, after which water service will be turned off. However, in no case will the service cut-off be effected before twenty (20) days after the mailing of the original bill. The notice shall also clearly state on its face that if the consumer disputes the bill for any reason,

the consumer may, within the three (3) day period, notify the WOU by mail, telephone, or personal visit, that the bill is disputed and ask for an Administrative Hearing. The notice shall give the telephone number of WOU and shall further inform the consumer of the customer's right to be represented by an attorney and advise the consumer to bring witnesses and documents in support of his claim to the hearing.

1.28 Promptly upon receipt of notice from any consumer that a bill is disputed, said consumer shall be notified of the date of the Administrative Hearing which shall be held at the offices of WOU. At that hearing, a hearing officer appointed by the Board of Directors as hereinafter provided, shall carefully consider all the evidence presented by the consumer and said hearing officer, at the conclusion of the hearing, shall advise the consumer of WOU's final determination as to the amount due. Notwithsatnding the foregoing, if for any reason, the hearing officer is unable to render a decision at the conclusion of an Adminstrative Hearing, he shall mail the connsumer a written notice of his decision as promptly as possible. The hearing officer shall have authority to reaffirm the amount owing, to excuse all or any part of such amount or to make a refund or allow credit to the consumer.

1.29 The Board of Directors shall appoint one or more of its employees to act as hearing officers to hear complaints by consumers relative to disputed water bills.

1.30 If the decision of the hearing officer is to the effect that some amount is still owing to WOU, and that amount is not paid within three (3) days after notice to the consumer, WOU will turn off said consumer's service without further notice. In this connection, WOU shall not be obligated to give the consumer a second written turn-off notice if the hearing officer has announced his decision at the conclusion of the Administrative Hearing, but if the hearing officer does not or is unable to announce a decision at the conclusion of the Administrative Hearing, the written decision shall be mailed to the consumer and the turn-off may take place

WOU Discontinuance of Service

1.31 When water service is turned off at any location for any reason, a written notice that the service has been turned off will be mailed to last known address of customer.

1.32 Water service shall not be turned on again until the delinquent bill, or bills, of the consumer involved, as adjusted at the Administrative Hearing, have been paid in full.

1.33 Any consumer or subscriber violating, or permitting violations, of the WOU's rules and regulations governing the introduction, supply and consumption of water will be notified thereof, in writing, which notification will be left on the premises and mailed to the last known address of customer. If the consumer then fails to comply promptly with the order of the WOU the water will be shut off.

134 (1) WOU may refuse or discontinue to serve an applicant or customer under the following conditions:

(a) For noncompliance with its rules and regulations. However, WOU shall not discontinue or refuse service to any customer or applicant for violation of its rules or regulations without first having made a reasonable effort to induce the customer or applicant to comply with its rules and regulations. After such effort on the part of WOU, service may be discontinued or refused only after the customer shall have been given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice of such intention, mailed to his last known address.

(b) When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service may be cut off without notice or refused, provided that WOU shall notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be restored.

(c) When a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises for the purpose of installation, operation, meter reading, maintenance or removal of utility property, WOU may discontinue or refuse service only after the customer or applicant shall have been given at least fifteen (15) days' written notice of such intention.

(d) WOU shall not be required to furnish service to any applicant or customer when such applicant or customer is indebted to WOU for service furnished until such applicant or customer shall have paid such indebtedness.

(e) WOU may refuse or discontinue service to a customer or applicant if the customer or applicant does not comply with state, municipal or other codes, rules and regulations applying to such service.

(2) The WOU may discontinue service under the following conditions:

(a) For nonpayment of bills. However, WOU shall not discontinue service to any customer for nonpayment of bills (including delayed charges) without first having made a reasonable effort to induce the customer to pay same. The customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, but the cut-off shall not be effected before twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill. If, prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to WOU, or to its employee empowered to discontinue service a written certificate signed by a physician, a registered nurse or a public health officer that, in the opinion of the certifier discontinuance of service will

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aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until ten (10) days elapse from the time of the utility's receipt of said certification, whichever first occurs.

(b) For fraudulent or illegal use of service. When WOU has discovered evidence that by fraudulent or illegal means a customer has obtained unauthorized service or has diverted the service for unauthorized use or has obtained service without same being properly measured, the service to the customer may be discontinued without notice. WOU shall not be required to restore service until the customer has complied with all rules of WOU and regulations of the commission and WOU has been reimbursed for the estimated amount of the service rendered and the cost to WOU incurred by reason of the fraudulent use.

(3) It shall be the duty of WOU before making service connections to a new customer to ascertain the condition of the meter and service facilities for such customer in order that prior fraudulent use of the facilities, if any, will not be attributed to the new customer, and the new customer shall be afforded the opportunity to be present at such inspection. WOU shall not be required to render service to such customer until all defects in the customer-owned portion of the service, if any, shall have been corrected.

(4) Reconnection. For all cases of refusal or discontinuance of service as herein defined, where the cause for refusal or discontinuance has been corrected and all rules and regulations of WOU have been complied with, WOU shall promptly render service to the customer or applicant.

(5) When advance notice is required, such notice may be given by WOU by mailing by United States mail, postage prepaid, to the last known address of the applicant or customer.

SPECIAL CHARGES

1.35 (1) WOU will make a reasonable charge for each of the following trips:

✓ (a) To collect a delinquent bill a \$10.00 charge will be assessed. This trip may be made only after written notice has been sent to the customer stating that if the bill is not paid by a certain date, the service will be disconnected.

✓ (b) To reconnect a service that has been disconnected for nonpayment of bills or for violation of WOU's rules and regulations a charge of \$20.00 will be assessed. This charge shall include the cost of disconnecting the service.

✓ 1.36 Should any check received by the WOU from a customer for water service be dishonored by the bank upon which it was drawn, the WOU will impose upon the customer for sending such a check a penalty charge of five dollars (\$5.00) which, together presented, must be paid immediately, or water service will be discontinued because of the provisions contained here, the water service will not be restored until the penalty charges referred to in section 1.32 shall have been paid in addition to the penalty charges imposed by this paragraph.

Damage to WOU Facilities

1.37 In all cases where fire hydrants or the WOU's pipes, fixtures, or valves are broken, cut, injured, or caused to leak in the streets or sidewalks by excavations made, or acts performed by any person or corporation whatsoever, the WOU shall render correct bills of actual cost for repairing same and charges for water loss, and the Treasurer shall collect the amount thereof from the person or corporation by whose acts such injury or damage may have been caused.

Combined Billing

1.38 Where, in accordance with the provisions of applicable

regulations, more than one service pipe service serves a single premise, if such service pipes are inter-connected within the consumer's premises, if the entire consumption within the premises cannot be supplied by any one of such services, and if, because of the capacity of the WOU's grid system, any one of such services cannot be enlarged to supply the full requirements of the premises, then the water used, as indicated by the sum of the readings of the meters on these services, may, with the prior approval of the Board of Directors, for the purpose of computing the bill for water used at this premise, be considered as having been registered by one meter.

Fire Protection Service

1.39 Services for fire protection, standpipes, fire hydrants and automative sprinklers will be installed at the expense of the applicant, and shall be sized from four (4) to twelve (12) inches in diameter, as the WOU may determine.

Persons or applicants desiring such services shall be granted under covenant with the WOU that they will not use water from such attachments for any purpose except for preventing or extinguishing fires. In the event of any unauthorized use, the WOU, at its option, may discontinue the service or services or install meters at the expense of the person or applicant to control the entire flow on such services.

Charges for Fire Protection Service

1.40 The charges for fire protection service will be made in accordance with the rate schedule, and will be billed monthly or as the WOU may hereafter designate and shall be billed to the fire protection district or the individual consumer, as the case may be. The charge for water used, shown by the meter registration, will be billed in addition to the scheduled ready-to-serve charge at the established meter rates without application of the minimum bill or allowable use.

Estimating of Consumption

1.41 In the event that the WOU representative, calling on his regular appointed rounds, cannot readily gain access to the consumer's meter, for the purpose of determining the meter reading, or in the event of inclement weather, then the WOU shall make its best estimate of the consumption that might be registered by that meter since the date the meter was last read, and prepare a bill based on this estimate. Such bill shall be treated by the WOU as if the reading of the meter had actually been determined. There shall not be more than three (3) consecutive estimated bills and, after the third such bill has been prepared, the WOU shall determine the reading of the meter, and the next bill shall be based upon an actual reading. Estimated bills will be marked distinctly as such.

Incorrect Registration of Meter

1.42 When a meter is found to be inoperative and does not correctly register the amount of water passing through it, the WOU shall make its best estimate of the consumption that would normally have been registered by that meter since the date of the last current reading on which a bill was rendered, and prepare a bill based on this estimate. Such bill shall be treated by the WOU as if the meter had been correctly registering consumption of water.

Enforcement of Rules

1.43 The rules and regulations shall be strictly and impartially enforced by such officers or agents as the Board of Directors may appoint. Such officers or agents shall have unrestricted, reasonable access, at proper hours in the day, to all premises supplied with water from the WOU for making such examinations and inspections of fixtures as may from time to time be deemed necessary.

WATER MAIN EXTENSION AND CONSTRUCTION
OF ATTENDANT FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

2.01 WOU will extend its water mains in accordance with 807 KAR 25.050(12), upon proper application, to serve a customer or group of customers provided such request is reasonable, feasible, and the proposed main extension and the water requirements thereof will not adversely affect the adequacy or quality of service to existing customers of the WOU, and will not otherwise impair the service or the financial structure of the WOU.

Ownership and Control

2.02 After the installation of an approved extension or the construction of attendant facilities and equipment by WOU, it shall become the sole property, and be under the exclusive control and management, of the WOU, and said shall have the right to further extend such extension or to make connections thereto for other extensions or to use the attendant facilities and equipment, for itself, and for other parties who may make proper application for further extensions, all without the consent of the applicant for whom said extension was made.

Minimum Size for Water Main and Fire Hydrants

2.03 The minimum size water main from which a fire protection water supply is or may be required shall be six (6) inches. The cost of the main extension shall include the cost of the fire hydrants, if such are required by the governing authority.

Compliance With Public Rules and Regulations

2.04 No application for water main extensions shall be approved by the WOU until the applicant has furnished satisfactory evidence that he (it) has fully complied with all pertinent laws and lawful rules and regulations promulgated by any commission or board having jurisdiction over property to be served. An approved plat of the proposed subdivision, together with construction plans, and sewer drawings, will also be furnished by the applicant prior to approval.

Rights of Way

2.05 No application for water main extensions will be approved until or unless the streets or roadways in which they are to be installed have been legally dedicated to public use in compliance with the pertinent statutes, rules and regulations of the appropriate public agency, or accepted as dedicated public ways by County Court or State Highway Commission by recorded deeds.

Street Grade Restriction

2.06 The WOU reserves the right to refuse to install a

PUBLIC FIRE HYDRANTS

Fire Hydrants Required to be Installed

3.01 Public fire hydrants shall be installed when required by the governing authority, and at the applicant's expense, as a part of the water main extension, or individually on existing mains of the WOU. The cost of such fire hydrants shall be considered a part of the cost of the water main extension.

Ownership of Fire Hydrants

3.02 Such fire hydrants shall become the property of the WOU upon installation and shall be operated and maintained by the fire protection district concerned.
