

(23) TEMPORARY SERVICE - Continued

estimated usage of electricity. Upon termination of temporary service the payment paid on estimated usage will be adjusted to actual usage, either a refund or additional billing will be issued to such temporary member or customer.

(24) DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

The Cooperative may refuse to connect or continue service to a member under the following conditions:

- a. Non-payment of bills.
b. Fraudulent or illegal use of service. If the meter or other equipment belonging to the Cooperative is tampered or interfered with or the appearance of current-theft devices on the premises of the member, the consumer supplied shall pay the amount the Cooperative estimates is due for service rendered but not registered on the Cooperative's meter and for such repairs and replacements as are necessary.
c. When dangerous conditions exist.
d. When applicant or member is indebted to the Cooperative for services furnished, until indebtedness is paid.
e. When applicant or member refuses to provide reasonable access to premises.
f. Non-compliance with state, local, and any other codes, rules and regulations that are applicable to providing service.

(25) CONSUMER'S WIRING STANDARDS

All wiring of member or consumer must conform to Cooperative requirements and accepted modern standards, as exemplified by the requirements of the National Electrical Code. The Cooperative, however, assumes no responsibility in respect to type, standard of construction, protective equipment or the condition of the member's property, and will not be liable for any loss or injury to persons or property occurring on the premises or property of the member. The member will have complete responsibility for all construction, operation, and maintenance beyond the meter.

(26) INSPECTIONS

The Cooperative shall have the right, but shall not be obligated to inspect any installation before electricity is introduced, or at any later time, and reserves the right to reject any wiring or appliances not in accordance with the National

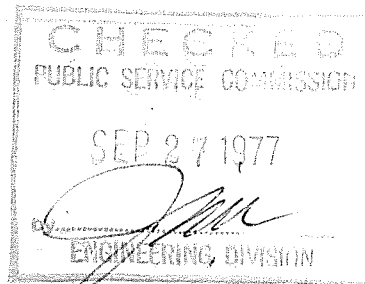
