Available to all commercial and industrial consumers for all uses provided the required transformer capacity does not exceed 25 KVA; and subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative covering this type of service.

Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service for both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule using the rate set out below. If the consumer prefers, he make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule and rate, and his usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

Type of Services:

Single phase, and three-phase where available, at 120/240 volts, 60 cycle, alternating current. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.

Power Factor:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the percent power factor.

Minimum Monthly Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Where the Cooperative is required to extend or reinforce its distribution facilities, it may increase the minimum monthly charge to the extent necessary to assure the Cooperative adequate compensation for the added facilities. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section additional energy and demand shall be included in accordance with the foregoing schedule.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Services:

Consumers requiring service during not to exceed nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Temporary Service:

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. The Cooperative may require a deposit, in advance, of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

Special Provisions:

1. Delivery Point. If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

2. Lighting. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.

3. Primary Service. If service is furnished at 7200/12470 volts or above, a discount of 5% shall apply to the Demand and Energy charges. The Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage.
