Schedule 30		
Residential Weatherization A La Carte Program		
Purpose This program promotes increased implementation of weatherization improvements by providing incentive payments to eligible Customers who undertake and complete residential weatherization improvements in accordance with this program.		
Availability Each DSM program offered by the Cooperative is sponsored by Big Rivers Electric Corporation through tariffs applicable to the Cooperative. Each Cooperative DSM program's rates, terms and conditions are available to Customers of the Cooperative, subject to the limitations and eligibility requirements set forth in the Cooperative's tariffs and the sponsoring tariff of Big Rivers.		
Eligibility Any Customer served from a non-dedicated delivery point is eligible for a DSM program.		
Member Incentives The Cooperative total reimbursement to the Rural Customer shall not exceed the amounts outlined below in Terms and Conditions.		
Terms & Conditions		
1. The eligible Rural Customer will contract with a qualified third party Contractor that performs weatherization projects, including duct sealing. Once the Contractor has determined that a Retail Customer's home is eligible for duct sealing as outlined in Item 2 below, residential weatherization may proceed. Any Retail Customer-selected Contractor's work and documentation must meet the standards of the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Department of Housing, Building, and Construction ("KDHBC"). Failure to meet KDHBC work and documentation standards may void any Big Rivers or Cooperative reimbursements outlined below.		
2. The Contractor will determine if the Rural Customers' home is eligible for duct sealing. Homes with a construction completion date within twenty-four months of the date of the site visit are not eligible for duct sealing. Homes eligible for duct sealing are those where 60% of the duct work is located outside conditioned spaces, <i>i.e.</i> , duct work located in attic, crawl space, or unfinished basement. Duct sealing reimbursement for homes is based on the following schedule.		
Home Heating Source	Paid by Cooperative	
Electric	Up to \$500	
Gas	Up to \$250	
The Rural Customer is responsible for all payments to the Contractor. Big Rivers' reimbursement to the Cooperative and the Cooperative's reimbursement to the Rural Customer as limited as stated above.

Residential Weatherization A La Carte Program			
Terms & Conditions			
3. Additional Weatherization incentives are available under this program. The Cooperative will reimburse the Rural Customer for these measures based on the following schedule:			
Additional Weatherization Measure	Electric-Heated Homes	Gas-Heated Homes	
Attic Insulation	Up to \$500	Up to \$250	
Floor/Crawl Space Insulation	Up to \$250	\$0	
Smart/Programmable Thermostat	Up to \$30	Up to \$30	
The Rural Customer will be responsible for contracting the service and submitting documentation to the Cooperative. The Rural Customer is responsible for all payments to the Contractor. Big Rivers' reimbursement to the Cooperative and the Cooperative's reimbursement to the Rural Customer are limited as stated above.			
4. To qualify for the additional weatherization incentives under this program, the Rural Customer must submit to the Cooperative or Big Rivers documentation supporting the purchase and installation of additional weatherization measures.			
(a) Attic insulation must achieve an additional insulating value of R19 and achieve a total insulation value of R38.			
(b) Floor insulation must achieve an additional insulating value of R11.			
5. Big Rivers and the Cooperative will complete all reimbursements upon completion of any of the above weatherization measures and submission of an application and required documentation.			
6. The Cooperative will promote this program.			
Evaluation, Measurement, and Verification:			
The Cooperative will follow a process of evaluation, measurement, and verification for the program. The process will ensure the quality and effectiveness of the program and optimal use of resources.			

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
