If the location of an existing pole is not suitable for the installation of a lighting unit, the Cooperative will extend its secondary conductor one span, not to exceed 150 feet, and install an additional pole for the support of such unit and the member shall pay an additional charge of .25¢ per pole per month per pole installed.
