RULES AND REGULATIONS

39. MEMBER EXTENSIONS EXCEEDING 1,000 FEET

- A. The Cooperative will build the first 1,000 feet or less of line without charge.
- B. When an extension of the Cooperative's line to serve a member or group of members amounts to more than 1,000 feet per member, the Cooperative will require the total cost of the excessive footage over 1,000 feet per member to be paid for by the member or members based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension prior to beginning of construction.
- C. The Cooperative shall refund to the member who paid for the original extension, a sum equivalent to the cost of 1,000 feet of the extension installed for each additional member connected directly to the extension, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the Cooperative. The member shall have the responsibility of contacting the Cooperative for any refunds under this section.
- D. The member must grant an easement to the Cooperative to take off the original line extension in order to receive a refund on the original deposit.
- E. Service drops are not included in the footage above.
- F. Subdivisions may be included in the above.
- G. The Cooperative shall calculate and render a bill for cost of excess footage and shall collect or see that cost is collected before release of the construction print.
