Schedule 2 (Cont.)

RATE
PER UNITTERM:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit, in advance may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

SPECIAL RULES:

If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten per cent (10%) shall apply to the demand and energy charge, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, service may be metered at secondary voltage and adjusted to primary metering ~~by adding~~ by adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.

RATE
PER UNITMINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$3.00 where 5 kva or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 5 kva of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by 75¢ for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. When it is necessary to extend or re-enforce existing distribution facilities the minimum monthly charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation to the added facilities. When the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms additional energy and demand shall be included in accordance with the foregoing rate schedule.

PER UNITSPECIAL RULES: (Cont.)Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows.

Power Factor Adjustment

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.
