\$1.25 per month per KW of billing demand PLUS ENERGY CHARGES:

2.5c per KWH for the first 20,000 KWH used per month

1.4¢ per KWH for the next 20,000 KWH used per month

1.0¢ per KWH for all remaining KWH used per month

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

POWER FACTOR

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 90%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or pecorded by the demand meter multiplied by 90% and divided by the pergent power factor.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

- Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10hp) must be three-phase.
- The consumer may connect lighting to power circuits from the power meter. Any additional transformers or regulating equipment which may be required for such lighting shall be furnished by the consumer.
- 3. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, exclusive of the service transformers and protective equipment, is considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
- Of service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten per cent (10%) shall apply to both bill and to the above minimum charges.
