SCHEDULE A-1-WH

FARM AND HOME SERVICE WITH STORAGE-TYPE WATER HEATER

Availability

Available to farm and home consumers who have in regular use a water heater conforming to the specifications set forth hereunder and who are receiving service at the same location for other usages. The rate capacity of any motor served under this schedule shall not exceed 10 horsepower.

Type of Service

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

Rate

First	15 kwh per month @	10.0¢	per kwh	
Next	25 kwh per month @	7.0¢	per kwh	
Next	40 kwh per month @	5.0¢	per kwh	
Next	120 kwh per month @	2.5¢	per kwh	
Next	300 kwh per month @	1.0¢	per kwh	
Over	500 kwh per month @	1.5¢	per kwh	(R)

Minimum Charges

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

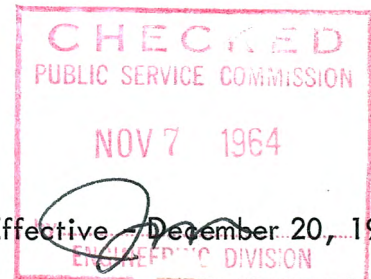

SCHEDULE A-1-WH (Cont.)

FARM AND HOME SERVICE WITH STORAGE-TYPE WATER HEATER

Conditions of Service

1. The consumer shall install and operate in regular use a standard approved storage-type of electric water heater and shall have no non-electric household water heating device in use during any part of the year (such as heating coils in a fuel-burning range or furnace).
2. Regardless of number of storage type water heaters connected to any single service only one block of 300 kwh per month at 1¢ per kwh will be allowed for any single service.
3. The standard approved type of water heater shall consist of an insulated tank containing two thermostatically controlled, non-inductive heating elements, so connected that only one element is permitted to operate any time. The capacity of the tank shall be sufficient to furnish an ample supply of hot water but in no case shall it be less than 30 gallons. The wattage of the heating elements may be a maximum of 4,500 watts on the upper element and a maximum of 4,500 watts on the lower element. The entire installation shall be subject to the approval of the Cooperative including the insulation and size of the tank, the wiring and the size of the heating elements.
4. Provision shall be made in the consumer's water heater wiring installation for an automatic control device which the Cooperative may install at its discretion.

FARM AND HOME SERVICE
All Electric Home Rate

Availability

Available only for electric service to consumers of the Cooperative located on its lines using electricity primarily for the purpose of home heating in addition to all other uses, including lighting, cooking, water heating, refrigeration, air conditioning and all incidental appliances. The capacity of individual motors served under this schedule shall not exceed 10 h.p.

Type of Service

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

Rate

First	15 KWH	per month	@	10.0¢ per KWH
Next	25 KWH	per month	@	7.0¢ per KWH
Next	40 KWH	per month	@	5.0¢ per KWH
Next	120 KWH	per month	@	2.5¢ per KWH
Next	300 KWH	per month	@	1.0¢ per KWH
Next	500 KWH	per month	@	1.5¢ per KWH
Over	1,000 KWH	per month	@	1.2¢ per KWH

Special Terms and Conditions

The above rates shall apply to all homes using all electric heat during the heating season only, from September 20 through April 20. This rider shall be subject to all rules and regulations, terms and conditions of Rate A-1-WH in addition to those special requirements set out herein-above.

Terms of Payment

The above rates are net and payment shall be due by the 10th of each month.
