RATE PER UNIT

APPLICABLE:

In all territory served by the Seller.

AVAILABILITY:

Available to all commercial and industrial consumers whose kilowatt demand shall exceed 100 KW for lighting and/or heating and/or power.

CONDITIONS:

An "Agreement for Purchase of Power" shall be executed by the Consumer for service under this schedule.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

The electric service furnished under this schedule will be 60 cycle, alternating current and at available nominal voltage.

RATE: MAXIMUM DEMAND CHARGE

\$1.25 per month per KW of billing demand.

SCHEDULE LP - 2 - LARGE POWER SERVICE

RATE
PER UNIT

Energy Charge

2.00 cents for the first	3,500 KWH used per month
1.30 cents for the next	6,500 KWH used per month
.85 cents for the next	140,000 KWH used per month
.75 cents for the next	200,000 KWH used per month
.65 cents for the next	400,000 KWH used per month
.55 cents for the next	550,000 KWH used per month
.45 cents for all in excess of	1,300,000 KWH used per month

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Power factor may be measured at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the per cent power factor.

SCHEDULE LP - 2 - LARGE POWER SERVICE

RATE PER UNIT

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges:

- (a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
- (b) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA per month of contract capacity.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE:

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWHR as the fuel cost adjustment per KWHR in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- 1. Delivery Point - If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

SCHEDULE LP - 2 - LARGE POWER SERVICE

RATE PER UNIT

If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

- 2. LIGHTING - Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.
- 3. PRIMARY SERVICE - If service is furnished at 7200/12470 volts or above, a discount of 5% shall apply to the Demand and Energy charges.

The Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage.
