

OPTIONAL POWER SERVICE	Schedule OPS	RATE Per Unit
<p>APPLICABLE: Consumers located in the Counties of Pulaski, Wayne, Clinton (including the City of Albany), McCreary and Russell, and consumers located in parts of the Counties of Casey, Lincoln, Rockcastle, Adair, Cumberland and Laurel in Kentucky.</p>		
<p>AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE: Available to power consumers located on or near Seller three-phase lines for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of Seller. It shall be optional with the consumer whether service will be billed under this schedule or any other schedule applicable to this load.</p>		
<p>TYPE OF SERVICE: Three-phase, 60 cycle, at Seller's standard voltages.</p>		
RATE:	<p>First 1000 kwh per month @ Over 1000 kwh per month @</p>	<p>3.5¢ 1.85¢</p>
<p>POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT: The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Billings under the above rate will be adjusted for consumers with 100 KVA or more of required transformer capacity to correct for average power factors lower than 35%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the monthly bill 1% by which the average power factor is less than 85% lagging.</p>		
<p>FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE: In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.</p>

OPTIONAL POWER SERVICE	Schedule OPS	RATE Per Unit
<p>MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE: The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) A charge of \$25.00 (2) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service. (3) A charge of 75¢ per KVA of required transformer capacity. The Seller may, if it so desires, install transformers of capacity larger than required; but in such case, the Consumer's minimum bill shall be based on the standard transformer size which would have been adequate for Consumer's load. <p><u>Service Provisions:</u></p> <p>1. Delivery Point--If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.</p> <p>If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.</p> <p>2. Lighting--Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registrations of the two watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt hours used.</p>

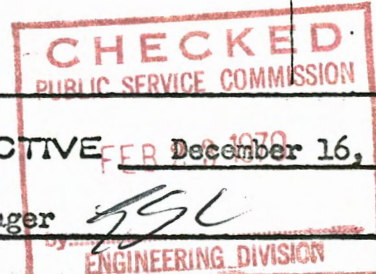

<p>3. Primary Service--If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall apply to the energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and kilowatt demand.</p>
