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## Wholesale Power Rate Schedule

#### BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand is the arithmetical sum of the maximum kilowatt demands measured (and adjusted for power factor as provided below) at all points of delivery. The maximum kilowatt demand at each point of delivery shall be the highest average rate at which energy is used during any fifteen consecutive minute period of the month.

#### FUEL ADJUSTMENT

The fuel clause shall provide for periodic adjustment per KWH of sales when (1)the unit cost of fuel [(F (m) ; S (m)] is above or below the base unit cost of 1.410¢ per KWH [(F (b) : S (b)] the current monthly charges shall be increased or decreased by the product of the KWH furnished during the current month and the Fuel Adjustment Rate for the preceding month where the Fuel Adjustment Rate is as defined below:

Fuel Adjustment Rate =  $\frac{F(m)}{S(m)} - \frac{F(b)}{S(b)}$

## FUEL ADJUSTMENT (Continued)

- (c) The net energy cost of energy purchases, exclusive of capacity or demand charges (irrespective of the designation assigned to such transaction) when such energy is purchased on an economic dispatch basis. Included therein may be such costs as the charges for economy energy purchases and the charges as a result of scheduled outage, all such kinds of energy being purchased by the buyer to substitute for its own higher cost energy; and less
- (d) The cost of fossil fuel recovered through inter-system sales including the fuel costs related to economy energy sales and other energy sold on an economic dispatch basis.
- (e) All fuel costs shall be based on weighted average inventory costing.
- (3) Forced outages are all nonscheduled losses of generation or transmission which require (purchase of) substitute power for a continuous period in excess of six (6) hours. Where forced outages are not as a result of faulty equipment, faulty manufacture, faulty design, faulty installations, faulty operation, or faulty maintenance, but are Acts of God, riot, insurrection or acts of the public enemy, then the utility may, upon proper showing, with the approval of the Commission, include the fuel cost of substitute energy in the adjustment.
- (4) Sales (S) shall be all KWH's sold, excluding inter-system sales. Where for any reason, billed system sales cannot be coordinated with fuel costs for the billing period, sales may be equated to the sum of (i) generation, (ii) purchases, (iii) interchange in, less (iv) energy associated with pumped storage operations, less (v) inter-system sales referred HoEifC K E D subsection (3) (d) above, less (vi) total system losses. UtPuitySumiedCommission energy shall not be excluded in the determination of sales (S). MAY 11 1981
- (5) The cost of fossil fuel shall include no items other than the invoice monomorprice of fuel less any cash or other discounts. The invoice praces AND TARIFFS fuel includes the cost of the fuel itself and necessary charges for transportation of the fuel from the point of acquisition to the unload-ing point, as listed in account 151 of FERC Uniform System of Accounts for Public Utilities and Licensees.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The member cooperative agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable at a point of delivery at the time of monthly maximum demand is determined to be less than 80%, the monthly maximum demand measured at that point of delivery shall be adjusted by multiplying the monthly maximum demand by 80% and dividing the product thus obtained by the actual percent power factor measured at the time of such maximum demand.

#### ENERGY EMERGENCY CONTROL PROGRAM

This tariff is subject to the Energy Emergency Control Program as filed with the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission (now the Public Service Commission) on February 23, 1981 in Administrative Case No. 238 and as approved by the Commission Order of March 31, 1981.
