Availability:

Available to members of the Cooperative for all farm and home uses subject to its established rules and regulations. The capacity of individual single-phase motors served under this schedule may not exceed ten (10) horsepower and the capacity of three-phase motors served under this schedule may not exceed thirty (30) horsepower.

Type of Service:


Single-phase 60 cycle at 120/240 volt alternating current or where available three-phase 4 wire 120/240 volt, 60 cycle alternating current, but not to exceed a total of 30 KVA of transformer capacity.

Rates:

First	25 KWH or less per month	\$2.50 per KWH
Next	25 KWH @	.06 per KWH
Next	50 KWH @	.04 per KWH
Next	100 KWH @	.025 per KWH
Next	200 KWH @	.024 per KWH
All Over	400 KWH @	.0125 per KWH

Minimum Charges:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding

Commercial and Small Power - Schedule 2B

Availability:

Available to all commercial and industrial consumers for all uses provided the billing demand is not in excess of 50 KW (OKW-50KW); and subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative covering this type of service.

Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service for both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule using the rate set out below. If the consumer prefers, he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule and rate, and his usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

Type of Service:


Single phase, and three-phase where available, at 120/240 volts, 60 cycle, alternating current. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10) must be three phase.

Rate: Energy Charge

First	25 KWH or less per month	\$2.50	Per KW
Next	25 KWH @	.06	Per KW
Next	50 KWH @	.04	per KW
Next	100 KWH @	.035	per KW
Next	800 KWH @	.030	per KW
All Over	1,000KWH @	.018	per KW

Demand Charge:

First 10 kilowatts of billing demand per month; no demand



Excess above 10 kilowatts of billing demand per month at \$1.50 per kilowatt.</p> <p><u>Determination of Billing Demand:</u> The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.</p> <p><u>Power Factor:</u> The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the percent power factor.</p> <p><u>Minimum Monthly Charge:</u> The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Where the Cooperative is required to extend or reinforce its distribution facilities, it may increase the minimum monthly charge to the extent necessary to assure the Cooperative adequate compensation for the added facilities. Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Services:

Consumers requiring service during not to exceed nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Temporary Service:


Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. The Cooperative may require a deposit, in advance, of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

Service at Primary Voltage:

If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten percent (10%) shall apply to the minimum charge. However, the Cooperative shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt hours and kilowatt demand.

Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net and are due on the last day of each month, the gross rates being 5% higher on the first \$15.00 and 2% higher on the remainder of the bill. In the

Available to public buildings, schools, churches, camps, barns, out-buildings, and seasonal residences for all uses subject to the Cooperative's established rules and regulations covering this type of service. Service under this schedule is limited to individual motors up to and including ten horsepower (10 H.P.).

Type of Service:

Single phase, 60 cycle at 120/240, alternating current.



Minimum Charges:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA or transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.
