


RULES AND REGULATIONS

30. SERVICE TO MOBILE HOMES (CON'T)

3. For extensions greater than 300 feet and less than 1,000 feet from the nearest facility, the utility may charge an advance equal to the reasonable costs incurred by it for that portion of the service beyond 300 feet plus fifty dollars (\$50.00). Beyond 1,000 feet the extension policies set forth in 807 KAR 2:050, Section 10 apply.
 - (a) This advance shall be refunded to the customer over a four (4) year period in equal amounts for each year the service is continued.
 - (b) If the service is discontinued for a period of sixty (60) days, or should the mobile home be removed and another not take its place within sixty (60) days, or be replaced by a permanent structure, the remainder of the advance shall be forfeited.
 - (c) No refunds shall be made to any customer who did not make the advance originally.
- B. The fees and advances paid will not give the Applicant any right, title or interest in any of the equipment.
- C. The membership fee and deposit will be handled in accordance with the other membership fees and deposits and the applications for same are separate from this application.
- D. The inspection fee of \$10.00 cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- E. The member shall have mounted on the Cooperative's pole nearest to the trailer a meter base and a water-proof service switch of sufficient size to serve the load for the trailer. The wiring on the pole must be of a workmanlike manner and all lines leading from the pole must be controlled by some kind of fused disconnect. The member shall furnish the wire which runs from the meter pole to the point of use. The installation shall be grounded and the Cooperative wiring inspector shall inspect the installation before the service is connected.
