Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of this maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85%, and divided by the percent power factor.

MINIMUM MONTHLY ENERGY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges:

- (a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
