



If on the bill due date an attempt to pay by credit card/debit card or ACH Bank Draft is made and the card/ACH Bank Draft is declined for any reason, payment is still due in full on that date and will be considered late after that date. All late charges will be applied. If a customer is paying on our disconnect day and the card is declined, the same rules as above apply, in addition to service being disconnected.

BUDGET BILLING

Customers have an opportunity to sign-up with the Utility for a budget billing plan whereby the customer elects to pay a fixed amount each month in lieu of monthly billings based on actual usage, thus spreading billing evenly over the year with a reconciliation done at the end of June and shown on the July bill. On rare occasions when a customer's usage has moved outside of the parameters used in the initial budget billing calculation, a January recalculation of the budget amount may be necessary, that will appear on the February bill, in order to reduce the possibility of the customer owing an excessive amount on the settle-up July bill.

CONNECTION FEE

A charge shall be assessed for all service connections, except that there shall be no connection charge made for service on the original installation of facilities. All connections shall be made during regular working hours. The amount of the charge is listed in the Non-recurring Charges portion of this tariff.

DEPOSITS

The Utility requires a cash deposit to secure payment of bills, an equal amount not to exceed 2/12 of the average annual bill that is listed on Sheet 2 of this tariff. Service will be refused or discontinued if payment of deposit is not made.

Deposits may be waived by considering these criteria: (a) previous history with the utility; (b) whether the customer has an established income or line of credit; (c) length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area; (d) whether the customer owns the property to be served; (e) another customer with a good payment history signs as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

Interest will accrue on all deposits at the rate prescribed by law beginning on the date of the deposit. Interest accrued will be refunded to or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis. If interest is paid or credited prior to twelve (12) months from the date of the deposit or last interest payment date, the payment or credit shall be prorated.

Deposits will be refunded to a customer after twelve (12) months if the customer has established a satisfactory payment history or upon termination of service. Satisfactory payment history is defined as no disconnects or no more than three (3) late payment fees assessed during the twelve (12) months.

If a deposit is waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a new deposit may then be required. If substantial change in usage has occurred, the Utility may require that an additional deposit be made. However, no additional or subsequent deposit shall be required of residential customers whose payment record is satisfactory unless the customer's classification of service changes.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE WITH NOTICE

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for noncompliance with the Utility's tariff or Public Service Commission rules and regulations, for refusal of access to the premises, for outstanding indebtedness, for noncompliance with state/local/other codes, and for nonpayment of bill(s).

The Utility cannot discontinue gas service without providing the customer a 10-day written notice of intent to terminate service. When the termination is for nonpayment of bill(s) the customer shall be given at least a 10-day written notice, separate from the original bill, and service cannot be terminated before 27-days after the mailing date of the original unpaid bill, unless prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not occur less than 30-days from the date the Utility notifies the customer, in writing, of state and federal programs which may be available to aid in payment of bills and the office to contact for such possible assistance.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE WITHOUT NOTICE

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer without advance notice for a dangerous condition(s) relating to the service, for unauthorized use/theft, or for tampering with the Utility system.

If termination is due to a dangerous condition(s) relating to the service, the Utility shall notify the customer immediately in writing and, if possible, orally of the reasons for termination. Notice shall include the corrective action to be taken by the customer or utility before service can be restored or provided.

If termination is for unauthorized use/theft or for tampering with the Utility system, within 24-hours after termination the Utility shall send written notification to the customer stating the reason(s) for termination. Termination for unauthorized use/theft or for tampering with the Utility system is in addition to any legal remedies the utility may pursue.

In addition to the requirements set forth above, notices provided by the Utility shall also include the contact information for the Public Service Commission and a statement that the customer has the right to challenge the termination by filing a complaint with the Public Service Commission.

GAS COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The Utility shall file a gas cost recovery rate (GCR) with the Public Service Commission at least 30-days prior to the first day of each calendar quarter. The GCR shall become effective for the billing for services rendered on or after the first day of each calendar quarter.

The gas cost recovery rate is comprised of:

1. The expected gas cost (EGC) on a dollar per Mcf basis, which represents the average expected cost of purchased gas based on 12-months of actual usage.
2. The actual adjustment (AA) on a dollar per Mcf basis, which compensates for differences between previous quarters' expected gas cost and actual cost of gas. The AA shall be the equal sum of the AA for the reporting period and for the three preceding quarters.
3. The supplier refund adjustment (RA) on a dollar per Mcf basis, which reflects the refunds received from suppliers during the reporting period plus interest at a rate equal to one-half of one percent below the average 90-day commercial paper rate for the 12-month period. In the event of any large or unusual refund, the Utility may apply the refund procedures set forth herein.
4. The balance adjustment (BA) on a dollar per Mcf basis which compensates for any remaining under or over collections which have occurred as a result of prior actual refunds and balance adjustments.

$$\text{GCR} = \text{EGC} + \text{AA} + \text{RA} + \text{BA}$$

The GCR will be added to latest base tariff rates approved by Commission Order to arrive at the new total rate.

GAS COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE cont'd

Definitions. For the purpose of this tariff:

1. "Average Expected Cost" is the cost of purchased gas which results from the application of suppliers rates currently in effect, or reasonably expected to be in effect during the calendar quarter, on purchased volumes for the most recently available 12-month period, divided by the corresponding sales volume. In the event that line loss exceeds 5-percent, purchased volumes for the 12-month period shall be calculated as: sales volumes divided by .95. Where the calculations require the use of volumes used during a given period, and those volumes did not exist for a particular source for the entire period, or the Utility expects the volumes change substantially, the Utility may make appropriate adjustments to its calculations. Any adjustments of this type shall be described in the quarterly GCR application.
2. The "GCR" is the total of the expected gas cost and all adjustments.
3. The "Calendar Quarters" are: January, February, and March; April, May, and June; July, August, and September; October, November, and December.
4. "Reporting Period" means the three-month accounting period that ended approximately 60-days prior to the filing date of the updated gas cost recovery rates, i.e. the calendar quarters ended March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31 of each year.

METER RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate a meter, the cost will be paid by the party or parties requesting the relocation at actual cost.

METER TEST REQUEST

Upon request and payment of the approved meter test fee, the amount to be listed in the non-recurring section of this tariff, a customer may have his/her meter tested provided the request by the customer is not more frequent than once in a twelve month period. If the test shows the meter to be more than two percent (2%) fast, a refund of the collected meter test fee shall be made and the customer bill adjusted accordingly. If the meter is found to be running more than two percent (2%) slow, there will be no refund of the collected meter test fee and the customer bill will be recalculated and the amount due collected.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Customers shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known by the customer.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Customers shall protect the Utility's equipment located on their premises and shall not interfere with the Utility's property or permit interference except by a duly authorized representative of the Utility.

BUDGET PAYMENT PLAN AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made in duplicate between Western Lewis-Rectorville Gas District, a Kentucky Corporation with its principal office at Maysville, Kentucky (hereinafter called the "District") and _____ (hereinafter called the "Consumer") located at _____.

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of Consumer's request to make gas service payments under the District's Budget Payment Plan, the Consumer shall pay the District at a fixed amount each month in lieu of monthly billings based on actual usage; whereby, any difference in the actual amount due and the fixed amount paid each month shall be payable in full each year upon receipt of the June billing.

It is further agreed:

1. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rate under which the District purchases gas service at wholesale is modified, the District may make a corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder and the budget payment amount shall be adjusted accordingly.
2. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rates and/or Terms and Conditions as set forth in the District's Rate are adjusted or changed and said adjustments and/or changes are approved by the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission said adjustments and/or will become effective and supercede, cancel and replace rates and/or terms and conditions provided in existing rate prior to the effective date as set forth in the Energy Regulatory Commission's Order approving the adjustments and/or changes.
3. The Consumer agrees that monthly budget payments are subject to change where a trend develops indicating the amount set up is insufficient to result in a reasonable balance due in the June Billing Period; at which time, the difference in the fixed amount and actual cost of gas service is payable in full.
4. It is agreed that the Consumer shall make payment each month in the full amount of the Budget Payment as stated herein, irregardless of any accumulated charges credits for actual use. The accumulated charges or credits shall be adjusted on the June billing. Should the Consumer fail to make such budget payments by due date, service will be discontinued and entire balance becomes due and payable before service is restored. The Consumer shall be ineligible for future billings under the Budget Payment Plan.
5. This agreement shall continue from year to year, unless terminated by either party giving to the other notice in writing, subject to the provision stated in #4 above.

THEREUPON, it is agreed that _____ (Consumer) shall pay to Western Lewis-Rectorville Gas District each month, beginning with June billing, for gas service in the amount of \$ _____ under this Budget Billing Agreement, and shall pay in full annually the balance resulting from difference in actual usage and fixed amount paid each month in June billing. If a credit balance (overpayment) exceeds \$10.00 it shall be refunded upon request. Any credit balance less than \$10.00 will be applied on the succeeding month's bill.
