SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

3.1 Timing of Calls

The customer's long distance usage charge is based on the actual usage of GLOBAL TELCOIN, Inc. network. Usage begins the called party picks up the receiver. When the called party picks up is determined by hardware answer supervision in which the local telephone company sends a signal to the switch or the software utilizing audio tone detection. When software answer supervision is employed, up to 42 seconds of ringing is allowed before it is billed usage of the network. A call is terminated when the calling party hangs up.

Calculation of Distance 3.2

Usage charges for all mileage sensitive products are based on the airline distance between rate centers associated with the originating and terminating points of the call.

The airline mileage between rate centers is determined applying the formula below to the vertical and horizontal coordinates associated with the rate center involved. Company uses the rate centers and associated vertical and produced horizontal coordinates that are Communications Research in their NPA-NXX V & H Coordinates Tape and Bell's NECA Tariff No. 4.

Each customer card account is established with a specified available balance. The available balance is depleted on a real per call basis at the rates specified in this tariff.

The available balance and usage rates specified in this tariff are stated inclusive of taxes. Customers are notified of their available balance upon each entry into the Company's network.

When the available balance has been fully depleted, the customer may use another customer customer card account, provided there is an adequate balance remaining.

Prepaid Card Service is available to customers for originating calls from any business, residential, or pay telephone access line. Customers dial a 1-800 number followed by their customer card account authorization code. Customers are informed of their available balance and can place calls to any intrastate location until the customer card account available balance is fully depleted. Depletion of the available balance is based on minutes of use rounded up to the full minute.
