

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by East Pendleton Water District hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

The Utility furnishes water service to Customers located Northeast Pendleton County, Kentucky.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend water service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the Consumer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066E, Section 12, PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY EFFECTIVE

LINE RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the 5th day of each month and will be due and payable within 10 days. A 10% late payment penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account.

RULES & REGS

DEPOSITS:

1. The utility may require a minimum cash deposit or other guarantee to secure payment of bills.
2. Service may be refused or discontinued if payment of requested deposits is not made.
3. An equal deposit amount for each class of customers will be established based on the average annual bill of customers in that class. Deposit amounts will not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual bill of customers in each class where bills are rendered monthly. Deposit amounts are listed in the Rates and Charges section of this tariff.
4. Deposits may be waived for a customer showing satisfactory credit or payment history. In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered: (a) Previous history with the utility. If the customer has no previous history with the utility, statements from other utilities, banks, etc., may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit; (b) Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit; (c) Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area; (d) Whether the customer owns the property to be served; (e) Whether another customer with good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.
5. Interest will accrue on all deposits at the rate prescribed by law beginning on the date of the deposit. Interest accrued will be refunded to the customer or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis. In situations where a customer leaves the system with less than one year's service, since beginning service or since the customer's last interest payment date, interest will be refunded or credited to the customer on a prorated basis.
6. Deposits will be refunded to customers after 18 months if the customer has established a satisfactory payment history or upon termination of service.

CONTENTS

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for non-payment of bills. If discontinuance is for non-payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least five (5) days written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill, unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until not less than thirty (30) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES

The rate authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of water to the Applicant as computed upon rates of its wholesale suppliers then currently in effect under valid contracts or under wholesale tariffs of this Commission. For the purpose of this purchased water adjustment clause, these rates shall be considered as the base rate for purchased water. In the event there is an increase in this base rate the Applicant shall file with this Commission the following information:

(1) A copy of the wholesale supplier tariff or wholesale tariff of this Commission effecting the change in the base rate and a statement relative to the effective date of such proposed change.

(2) A statement setting out the details of water purchased under the provision of the base rate for the previous twelve months showing billing under the base rate and under the proposed revised rate applicable to this service.

(3) A statement setting out the details of water sold for the previous twelve months.

(4) A balance sheet as of the end of the latest twelve month period and a statement of operating expenses and revenues in the same detail as reported to this Commission in the Utility's Annual Report.

(5) Such other information as this Commission may request for a proper determination of the purchased water adjustment.

In the event there is a decrease in purchased water costs or refund, the Applicant shall file the information required in 1, 2, and 4 above.

Upon receipt of this information, this Commission will review the effect of the revised rate on the operation of the Applicant and will issue its order setting out the purchased water adjustment that the Utility shall apply to its rates. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY EFFECTIVE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The maximum amount of the adjustment so prescribed shall not produce revenue adjustments based upon the actual preceding twelve-month period, greater than the difference between the purchased water billed at the then existing rates and the purchased water billed at the revised rate.

On and after the effective date of this rate schedule, if any increase or decrease is made in the rate at which Company's water suppliers sell water to the Company, the unit charges of the aforesaid rate schedule shall be increased or decreased by a Purchased Water Adjustment determined as follows:

(1) Water Purchases will be determined by the Company under suppliers applicable rate schedule during a period of twelve calendar months ending within three months preceding the month of the effective date of the supplier's rate change. Such purchases shall be:

- (a) At the Base Supplier Rate
- (b) At the New Supplier Rate

(2) The difference between the amounts so determined shall be divided by the number of cubic feet/gallons of water sold by the Company during the said twelve-month period. The unit charged or credit so determined, expressed in cents per cubic feet/gallons, shall be the Purchased Water Adjustment applicable to consumer billings, unless water loss exceeding fifteen (15) percent.

(3) If the water loss exceeds fifteen (15) percent, the actual water sales shall be divided by eighty-five (85) percent yielding the maximum allowable water purchases. The maximum allowable water purchases will then be multiplied by the change in cost per gallons, yielding the total allowable change. The total allowable change shall then be divided by the actual number of gallons sold, yielding the purchased water adjustment expressed in cents per gallon.

(4) The new supplier rate shall become the Base Supplier Rate to be used in measuring the effect of any subsequent supplier rate change. Each such subsequent change shall be treated in the same manner as the establishment of a new Base Supplier Rate.

(2) Effective with meter readings taken on and after the first day of the second month following receipt of the refund, the Company will reduce by the Refund Factor so determined and Purchased Water Adjustment that would otherwise be applicable during such period. Provided, however, that the period of reduced Purchased Water Adjustment will be adjusted, if necessary, in order to refund as nearly as possible the Refundable Amount.

(3) In the event of any large or unusual refunds, the Company may apply to the Public Service Commission for the right to depart from the refund procedure herein set forth. T

EXTENSIONS OF MAINS TO APPLICANTS FOR SERVICE

1. EXTENSIONS OF 50 FEET OR LESS PER APPLICANT.

AN APPLICANT WITH A POINT OF SERVICE THAT CAN BE REACHED BY A MAIN EXTENSION OF 50 FEET OR LESS WILL BE PROVIDED SERVICE WITHOUT CHARGE FOR THE MAIN EXTENSION ITSELF IF AN AGREEMENT TO USE SERVICE FOR ONE YEAR IS MADE AND A GUARANTEE THEREOF IS PROVIDED. THE UTILITY WILL BEAR THE COST OF THE MAIN EXTENSION. THE APPLICANT'S COST WILL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE UTILITY'S APPROVED TARIFFS FOR METERED SERVICE CONNECTIONS.

IN LIKE MANNER, THE UTILITY WILL BEAR THE COST OF AN EXTENSION OF 100 FEET FOR 2 APPLICANTS, 150 FEET FOR 3 APPLICANTS, 200 FEET FOR 4 APPLICANTS, ETC. THIS MAY BE REFERRED TO AS THE "50 FOOT RULE". THE REGULATION FOR EXTENSIONS OF MORE THAN 50 FEET PER APPLICANT ARE DEFINED UNDER THE REGULATION HEREIN BY THAT TITLE.

2. EXTENSIONS OF MORE THAN 50 FEET PER APPLICANT.

APPLICANTS THAT CANNOT BE REACHED BY 50 FEET OF EXTENSION PER APPLICANT WILL PAY FOR THE EXTENSION FOOTAGE THAT EXCEEDS 50 FEET PER APPLICANT. THEIR COST WILL BE BASED ON THE AVERAGE COST PER FOOT OF THE EXTENSION MULTIPLIED BY THE EXCESS FOOTAGE; WITH EACH APPLICANT BEARING AN EQUAL SHARE OF THIS COST.

APPLICANTS WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO RECOVER SOME OF THEIR COST AS NEW APPLICANTS ARE CONNECTED DIRECTLY TO THE EXTENSION: (A) FROM THE 5 YEAR COST SHARING PLAN DESCRIBED HEREIN AND (B) FROM THE 10 YEAR (50 FOOT REFUND) PLAN DESCRIBED BY REGULATIONS OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION: 807 KAR 5:066, SECTION 12.2 (B). DURING THE "10-YEAR REFUND PLAN", THE APPLICANTS OF INTEREST IN THE EXTENSION WILL RECEIVE EQUAL SHARES OF THE DOLLAR VALUE OF 50 FEET OF THE EXTENSION FOR EACH NEW APPLICANT CONNECTED DIRECTLY TO THE EXTENSION. DURING THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF THE "COST SHARING PLAN", AN EQUAL SHARE OF THE CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED OF NEWLY CONNECTED APPLICANTS WILL BE REFUNDED BY THE DISTRICT TO ALL APPLICANTS OF INTEREST AND EACH NEWLY CONNECTED APPLICANT WILL BECOME AN APPLICANT OF INTEREST IN THE EXTENSION AFTER THEIR CONTRIBUTION IS RECEIVED BY THE DISTRICT. THE CONTRIBUTION FOR EACH NEW APPLICANT WILL BE BASED ON A RECOMPUTATION OF DISTRICT'S SHARE OF COST AND APPLICANT'S SHARE OF COST IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE METHOD SHOWN ON ATTACHMENT NUMBER 1 TO THIS REGULATION.

Leak Adjustments.

East Pendleton County Water District will recalculate and a adjust a bill for water service under the following conditions:

1. The customer makes a written request for an adjustment due to a leak or faulty equipment on the customer side of water meter. This request must state the nature of the faulty equipment or leak, be accompanied by documentary evidence that repairs have been performed (e.g., itemized receipt for repair materials), and be given under oath. When a licensed plumber performs the repair work, the customer should provide a sworn statement or billing invoice from a licensed plumber stating the nature of the leak and the repairs performed and itemized receipts for repair materials.
2. An adjustment for a leak or faulty equipment shall be made only once during a 12-month period.

Calculation of Billing Adjustment: The customer's adjusted bill will be the sum of the customer's average monthly usage over a 12-month period billed at the utility's effective rates at the time of service and the difference between the customer's actual usage for the period in question and average monthly usage over a 12-month period billed at the rate that is \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons less than the present rate. If meter readings are not available for an entire 12-month period, the utility may estimate water usage, subject to an upward or downward adjustment once a 12-month average of actual meter readings can be calculated.

D. Special Non-recurring Charges:

1. The utility will collect for special nonrecurring charges to recover customer-specific costs incurred which would otherwise result in monetary loss to the utility or increased rates to other customers to whom no benefits accrue from the service provided or action taken. The utility may establish or change any special nonrecurring charge by applying for Public Service Commission approval of such charge in accordance with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10.
2. Special nonrecurring charges will be applied uniformly throughout the area served by the utility. Such charges will relate directly to the service performed or action taken and only yield enough revenue to pay the expenses incurred in rendering the service.
3. The utility will assess a charge for the following non-recurring services:
 - a) Connection/Turn-on Charge: Will be assessed for new service turn-ons, seasonal turn-ons, temporary service, or transfer of service. The charge will not be made for initial installation of service where a meter connection/tap-on charge is applicable.
 - b) Field Collection Charge: Will be assessed when a utility representative visits the premises of the service connection to terminate service, and the customer is on-site and pays the bill to avoid termination of service. This fee may only be charged once per billing period.
 - c) Late Payment Penalty: Will be assessed on the delinquent amount of the bill, less taxes.
 - d) Meter Relocation Charge: Will be assessed when a customer or other authorized person requests that a meter be relocated, changed, or modified. Those requesting a change must reimburse the utility for the actual costs

- e) Meter Re-read Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the utility to re-read the customer's meter and the re-read proves that the original meter reading was correct.
- f) Meter Test Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the utility perform a test on the customer's meter to check for accuracy, and the test shows the customer's meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast.
- g) Reconnection Charge: Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations, and will include the cost of the service trip for both the disconnection and the reconnection.
- h) Returned Check Charge: Will be assessed when a customer's check is returned, either due to insufficient funds or other reason due to customer fault.
- i) Service Call/Investigation Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the onsite presence of utility personnel to investigate a service problem and the problem is a result of the customer's own plumbing facilities, beyond the utility's delivery point, or not caused by failure of utility facilities. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond the utility's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.
- j) Service Line Inspection Charge: Will be assessed to inspect a customer's service line from the point of delivery at the meter service to the point of usage. The service line inspection charge will be waived if confirmation is received from the Kentucky State Plumbing Inspector that a state plumbing

FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$ 100.00 for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.

WITNESSETH THAT for and in consideration of the efforts of the party of the second part, acting through District Commissions, the party of the First Part agrees to pay a connection fee of **\$1390** at the time of signing this contract; to connect to the water system and to pay at least a minimum bill monthly thereafter as soon as the **5/8" x 3/4" meter** is installed by the District and water is made available to the meter regardless of whether the first party connects to the system.

The Party of the First Part agrees to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, and remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on the customers property to be designated by the District for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property.

The Party of the First Part agrees that no other present or future source of water will be connected to any waterlines served by the Districts waterlines and will disconnect from his present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the Districts system and shall eliminate their present of future cross-connection in his system.
