

II. BILLING INFORMATION

1. Bills for water service will be rendered monthly and shall be paid by the due date listed on the bill. Failure to receive a bill will not release the customer from payment obligations.
2. Should bills not be paid by the due date, the District may, at any time thereafter and upon ten days written notice to the customer, discontinue service. Service shall not, for any reason, be disconnected before twenty days after the mailing date of the original unpaid bill.
3. Bills paid on or before the due date shall be payable at the net rate. The late payment penalty in the Rates and Charges Section of this tariff will be assessed if a customer fails to pay a bill for services by the due date.
4. Should the due date fall on a weekend or a holiday, the next business day following the due date will be held as a day of grace for delivery of payment.
5. Customers who have more than one dwelling on a meter will be charged two flat rates and any extra over will be charged to the account holder.

VII. SPECIAL NON-RECURRING CHARGES

1. Late Payment Penalty: Will be assessed on the delinquent amount of the bill, less taxes. The late payment penalty may be assessed only once on any bill for rendered services. Additional late payment penalties shall not be assessed on unpaid late payment penalties.
2. Reconnection Charge: Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations, and will include the cost of the service trip for both the disconnection and the reconnection. Once the cause for disconnection of service has been corrected and the District's tariffed rules and Public Service Commission regulations have been met, service will be reconnected within twenty-four (24) hours or by close of the next business day, whichever is later.

Legal Disclaimers.

1. The utility shall in no event be held responsible for any claims made against it for reasons of system failure or interruption of service. No person shall be entitled to damages or for any portion of a payment refunded for any system failure or interruption of service which is deemed necessary.
2. No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure, appurtenance or equipment which is a part of the utility's water system. Any person violating this provision will be subject to discontinuance of water service and shall be assessed the cost of repairing or replacing the utility's facilities.
3. If any loss or damage to the property of the utility or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of a customer, members of his/her household, his/her agent or employee, then the cost of necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer of the utility and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.
4. For purposes of fire protection, including any customer's fire protection system, the utility cannot guarantee a water supply at any particular flow rate or pressure. The fire flow may vary depending upon other water demands on the system, various water facility limitations, or other circumstances. The customer will indemnify and hold harmless the utility and its employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses incurred as a result of insufficient water supply or deficient system facilities.

All late charges and penalties will be applied. If a customer is paying on our disconnect day and the card is declined, the same rules as above apply, in addition to service being disconnected.

The processor (not the district) will assess a convention fee for providing this service.



IV. DEPOSITS

All Customers will pay a deposit for each hook-up. The amount applies to everyone whether it is a business or a residence. The deposit will not exceed an amount that is greater than 2/12 of the annual bill of the average customer.

Interest on deposits will be calculated annually according to KRS 74.050. Interest accrued shall be refunded to the customer or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis.

The deposit will be refunded within two (2) years and will include the appropriate amount of interest. This refund applies both to land-owners and rental properties.

Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and interest earned shall be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

When a deposit has been returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, the District may require that a new deposit be made.

FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 10th day of the following calendar month or the next business day if the 10th falls on a weekend or a holiday.

Any User that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water. A User shall submit a monthly report even if it withdraws no water for fire protection or training purposes.

A non-reporting User's usage shall be presumed to be 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting User may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and shall adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting User shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting User shall also be assessed a penalty of **\$100.00** for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner. If the report is not turned in and the penalty is not paid, North Hopkins Water District will turn the matter over to the Hopkins County Attorney.

WATER USER AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into between _____ (User's Name),

whose address is _____, hereinafter called "USER", and the North Hopkins Water District, 316 Liberty Church Loop, Madisonville, Kentucky, hereinafter called "SUPPLIER".

WHEREAS, the USER desires to purchase water from the SUPPLIER, the USER hereby enters into this water users agreement as required by the Bylaws of the SUPPLIER.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

The SUPPLIER shall furnish, subject to the limitations set out in it's Bylaws and Rules and Regulations now in force or as hereafter adopted, such quantity of water as the USER may desire in connection with the property to be served by this agreement. The property to be served is a _____ (Residence, Mobile Home, Etc.), located on _____ (Street, Highway, Road).

The USER shall install and maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The location of the water meter on the property will be determined by the SUPPLIER. The SUPPLIER shall purchase and install a cutoff valve and a water meter. The SUPPLIER shall have exclusive right to use such cutoff valve and water meter.

The USER shall connect his service lines to the water distribution system and shall commence to use water from the system on the date the water is available to him. WATER CHARGES TO THE USER WILL COMMENCE ON THE DATE SERVICE IS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE SUPPLIER, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE USER IS CONNECTED TO THE SYSTEM.

The USER agrees to pay a connection fee of \$ _____ to the SUPPLIER. If the water system is constructed, but the property covered by this agreement is not reached by the SUPPLIER'S water line, the connection fee will be fully refunded to the USER. Construction of water lines to serve the property covered under this agreement depends on feasibility, availability of funds for construction and approval of all local, state, and federal agencies having jurisdiction over this type of facility. THE SUPPLIER DOES NOT GUARANTEE WATER SERVICE WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE USER.

The USER agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the SUPPLIER, now in force or as hereafter duly and legally adopted, supplemented, amended, or changed. The USER agrees to pay for water at such rates, time and place as shall be determined by the SUPPLIER, and agrees to the imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the SUPPLIER'S Bylaws and Rules and Regulations, or which have been or hereafter be adopted and imposed by the SUPPLIER.

The SUPPLIER shall determine the allocation of water to the USER in the event of a water shortage ; and may shut off water to the USER if he allows a connection or extension to be made of his service line for the purpose of supplying water to another party. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of the users, or in the event there is a shortage of water, the SUPPLIER may pro-rate the water available among the various users on such basis as is deemed equitable by the GOVERNING BODY, and if at any time the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the need of all of the users, the SUPPLIER must first satisfy all of the needs of all users for domestic purposes before supplying any water for livestock purposes and must satisfy all the needs of all users for both domestic and livestock purposes before supplying any water for garden purposes.

The USER agrees that no present or future source of water will be connected to any waterlines served by the SUPPLIER'S waterlines and will disconnect from his present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the SUPPLIER'S system and shall eliminate present or future cross-connections in his system.

The failure of the USER to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

1. Nonpayment by the due date will be subject to a penalty of _____ percent of the delinquent account.
2. Nonpayment within ten (10) days from the due date will result in the water being shut off from the USER'S property.
3. In the event it becomes necessary for the SUPPLIER to shut off the water from the USER'S property, a fee of \$_____ will be charged for a reconnection of the service.

It is understood and agreed that the SUPPLIER reserves the right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply the water to the USER. A 5/8" X 3/4" meter will be used unless the USER contracts for a larger meter. A separate meter must be installed for each residence. A separate contract will be used by trailer parks when trailers are not supplied by individual meters.

The USER agrees to grant to the SUPPLIER, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement in, over, under and upon land owned by the USER, with the right to erect, construct, install, and lay, and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove water pipelines and appurtenant facilities, together with the right to utilize adjoining lands belonging to the USER for the purpose of ingress to and egress from the said lands.
