RULES AND REGULATIONS

NON-RECURRING CHARGES:

Field Collection Charges shall be assessed when a utility representative visits the premises of the service connection to terminate service, and the customer is on-site and pays the delinquent bill to avoid termination of service.

Meter Re-read Charges shall be assessed when a customer requests the utility to re-read the customer's meter and the re-read proves that the original meter reading was correct.

Meter Test Charges shall be assessed when a customer requests the utility perform a test on the customer's meter to check for accuracy, and the test shows the customer's meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast. The customer shall be given the opportunity to be present when the test is conducted.

Re-connection Charges shall be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of bills or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations.

Returned Check Charges shall be assessed when a customer's check is returned, either due to insufficient funds or other reason due to customer fault.

Turn-on Charges shall be assessed for new service turn-ons, seasonal turn-ons, or temporary service. The charge will not be made for initial installation of service where a tap-on connection fee is applicable.

All customers will pay a minimum cash deposit to secure payment of bills. If actual usage is available for the customer at the same or similar premises, the deposit amount will be calculated using the customer's average bill for the most recent 12 month period. If actual usage is not available, the deposit amount will be based on the average bill of similar customers and premises in the system. Deposit amounts will not exceed two twelfths (2/12) of the customer's actual or estimated annual bill.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by Pendleton County Water District hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SERVICE AREA

The Utility furnishes water service to Customers located in Central and Northern portion of Pendleton County, Kentucky.

AVAILABILITY

Water Service is available to any domestic, commercial or industrial consumer within the Utility's Area.

WATER FAILURE

The Utility is responsible for water failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for ~~equipment unless such~~ damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of ~~negligence on the~~ part of the Utility or its employees.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Utility on his premises and shall not interfere with Utility's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the Utility.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend water service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the Consumer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066E. Section 12.

LINE LOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the 5th day of each month and will be due and payable within 10 days.
N A 10% late penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account.

DEPOSITS

The Utility may require from any customer or applicant for service a cash deposit ~~or other guaranty~~ to secure payment of bills not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the ~~estimated annual bill~~ of such customer or applicant where bills are rendered monthly, or three-twelfths (3/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered bimonthly, or four-twelfths (4/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered quarterly. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum will be paid on deposits so required. ~~accruing from the date of deposit.~~

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations. or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills. If discontinuance is for non-payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, spearate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arragnements or until not less than ten (10) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found t exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused.

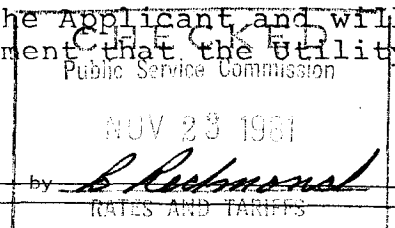
PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES

The rate authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of water to the Applicant as computed upon rates of its wholesale suppliers then currently in effect under valid contracts or under wholesale tariffs of this Commission. For the purpose of this purchased water adjustment clause, these rates shall be considered as the base rate for purchased water. In the event there is an increase in this base rate the Applicant shall file with this Commission the following information:

- (1) A copy of the wholesale supplier tariff or wholesale tariff of this Commission effecting the change in the base rate and a statement relative to the effective date of such proposed change.
- (2) A statement setting out the details of water purchased under the provision of the base rate for the previous twelve months showing billing under the base rate and under the proposed revised rate applicable to this service.
- (3) A statement setting out the details of water sold for the previous twelve months.
- (4) A balance sheet as of the end of the latest twelve month period and a statement of operation expenses and revenues in the same detail as reported to this Commission in the Utility's Annual Report.
- (5) Such other information as this Commission may request for a proper determination of the purchased water adjustment.

In the event there is a decrease in purchased water costs or refund, the Applicant shall file the information required in 1, 2, and 4 above.

Upon receipt of this information, this Commission will review the effect of the revised rate on the operation of the Applicant and will issue its Order setting out the purchased water adjustment that the Utility shall apply to its rates.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The maximum amount of the adjustment so prescribed shall not produce revenue adjustments based upon the actual preceding twelve-month period, greater than the difference between the purchased water billed at the then existing rates and the purchased water billed at the revised rate.

On and after the effective date of this rate schedule, if any increase or decrease is made in the rate at which Company's water suppliers sell water to the Company, the unit charges of the aforesaid rate schedule shall be increased or decreased by a Purchased Water Adjustment determined as follows:

(1) Water Purchases will be determined by the Company under suppliers applicable rate schedule during a period of twelve calendar months ending within three months preceding the month of the effective date for the supplier's rate change. Such purchases shall be:

(a) At the Base Supplier Rate

(b) At the New Supplier Rate

(2) The difference between the amounts so determined shall be divided by the number of cubic feet/gallons of water sold by the Company during the said twelve-month period, unless purchases is in excess of 115% of total sales. In such instance, said difference shall be divided by sales plus fifteen (15) percent. The unit charge or credit so determined, expressed in cents per cubic feet/gallons, shall be the Purchased Water Adjustment applicable to consumer billings.

(3) The new supplier rate shall become the Base Supplier Rate to be used in measuring the effect of any subsequent supplier rate change. Each such subsequent change shall be treated in the same manner as set forth above for the establishment of a new Base Supplier Rate.

In the event that the Company receives from its supplier a refund of amounts paid to such supplier in respect of a prior period, the Company will apply to the Commission for authority and upon receipt thereof make adjustments on the amounts charged to its customers under this provision, as follows:

(1) The "Refundable Amount" shall be the amount received by the Company as a refund. Such Refundable Amount shall be divided by the number of cubic feet/gallons of water that Company estimated it will sell to its customers during the four-month period commencing with the first day of the month following receipt of the refund, thus determining a "Refund Factor".

(2) Effective with meter readings taken on and after the first day of the second month following receipt of the refund, the Company will reduce by the Refund Factor so determined and Purchased Water Adjustment that would otherwise be applicable during such period. Provided, however, that the period of reduced Purchased Water Adjustment will be adjusted, if necessary, in order to refund as nearly as possible the Refundable Amount.

(3) In the event of any large or unusual refunds, the Company may apply to the Utility Regulatory Commission for the right to depart from the refund procedure herein set forth.

FIRE HYDRANTS

The fire hydrants installed on the distribution lines of this District are for the primary purpose of flushing the lines, or other uses by the District necessary for proper maintenance of the lines, and the secondary purpose is to assist fire protection units in the performance of their duties. The District is not responsible for, nor does it guarantee, any minimum pressure at these hydrants, other than the minimum pressure required by the Public Service Commission for distribution lines. Any damage to the distribution lines, resulting from excessive pumping pressure applied by any fire fighting unit will be the liability of that unit.

FIRE LINES

On all Fire Lines connected to the District's distribution lines a meter shall be required for the sole purpose of monitoring water usage with no minimum bill or charge for water used for fire protection, but bills are to be rendered for any water usage other than fire protection.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

- (1) The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
- (2) If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same, or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.
- (3) If the annual usage differs by 25 percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause the company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12 month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
- (4) If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as a different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.

- (5) Where the deviation is not otherwise explained the company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
- (6) The company will notify the customer of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, section 10(4) and (5). In addition to the annual monitoring, the company will immediately investigate usage deviation brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading or billing process or customer inquiry.

DEPOSITS

The company may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills. Interest as prescribed by KRS 278.460, 1 will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customers showing of satisfactory credit or payment history and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change of usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remaining amount refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

(1) Previous payment history with the company.
If the customer has no previous history with the company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.

(2) Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.

- (3) Length of time the customer has resided or been located in this area.
- (4) Whether the customer owns property in the area.
- (5) Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
- (6) Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer the company may collect any under payment and shall refund any over payment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of recalculation.

Leak Adjustment Procedure:

The Company reserves the right to adjust any customers bill to the per thousand gallon rate charged to the wholesale customer(s). This is a reduction from our normal rates currently on our tariff. RULES AND REGULATIONS

FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$50.00 (Fifty dollars) for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.
