

ADDENDUM TO WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT

THIS ADDENDUM is made and entered into this 22nd day of November, 1968, between the CITY UTILITIES COMMISSION of Corbin, Kentucky, and the CUMBERLAND FALLS HIGHWAY WATER DISTRICT, and modifies the provisions for their purchase contract between the parties dated May 15, 1968, as set out below:

WITNESSETH:

For a valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the parties amend the previous contract between them dated May 15, 1968, as follows:

"A. THE CITY AGREES:

1) (Quality and Quantity) To furnish the District, at the point of delivery hereinafter specified, during the term of this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable purity standards of the State Board of Health in such quantity as may be required by the District (not to exceed two million (2,000,000) gallons per month without the consent or acquiescence of the City).

In all other respects the previous contract is adopted and reiterated in its entirety.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, acting under authority of their respective governing bodies have caused this contract to be duly executed by their counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original.
