

Rate:

A rate of forty (40) cents per thousand cu. ft. is charged under each contract subject to a discount of five cents per thousand cu. ft. if paid on or before ten days following date of billing.

Special Conditions:

Each contract is for a period of six months and thereafter extended from month to month, subject to cancellation upon fifteen days' prior notice by either party.

It is understood that gas to be delivered pursuant to this Tariff is from gas well pipelines and/or gathering pipelines and due to the decrease in available gas from production areas, the pressure of the gas delivered may vary from time to time or may decrease to such an extent that it is no longer feasible to continue to operate such lines. At such times, Equitable Gas Company shall have the right to abandon gas service to any customer served from any line which is no longer feasible for operation.

Service pursuant to this rate schedule is available for all domestic consumers who prior to May 18, 1956, were taking gas from Kentucky West Virginia Gas Company at its Domestic Rate for gas service.
