RULES AND REGULATIONS

Budget Payment Plan

A. Implementation of Plan

The residential customers are to be notified of the implementation of the budget plan on March 15, 1980 and have until May 1, 1980 to respond to the plan. The budget payments would begin with usage for the period May 15, 1980 to June 14, 1980, payment of which would be in the first 12 days of July.

A prerequisite to participation in the plan would be that the customer's account be current at the start of the plan.

B. Plan Operation

The plan cycle will be for a twelve month period, beginning with the bill to be paid in July of each year. The June bill of each year will be a "settle up" bill if there is a balance due the company, or credit will be issued on subsequent bills if there has been an overpayment.


C. Computation of Budget Amount

The amount of the budget payment will be computed based on the previous 12 billing months usage times the rates in effect at the time of the computation. The average rate of consumption for all residential customers will be used for customers that do not have a previous 12 month history.

D. Delinquent Accounts

Any customers implementing the budget plan that do not maintain a current status as to budget payments will forfeit their right to participate, and the balance owed to a particular date will become payable immediately.
