

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of gas utilities which may be adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof which may be made by said Commission.
- II. Langley Supply Company's main line which is  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches is large enough to carry enough gas for approximately 50 dwelling houses at low pressure but customers mostly elect rate #3 as shown on next page and come to our  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch line with any size they elect, which are mostly  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch or less, thereby, causing said Langley Supply Company to carry from 2 to 5 lbs. pressure in order to supply ample amount of gas, depending on severity of the weather.
- III The small lines are not buried and get broken very often and come full of rust holes, and leaks arising from different causes are at least 15% of gas metered.



Applicable:

Entire territory served.

Availability of Service:

Available for domestic and commercial uses.

Rates:No. 1

35¢ per Mcf if customer sets meter immediately near our 2½ inch line and uses one low pressure regulator and carries 10 ounces on this regulator.

No. 2

40¢ per Mcf without regulating gas down to 10 ounces and meter is not more than 10 feet away from line.

No. 3

45¢ per Mcf when customer elects to set meter near dwelling house.
