

RULES AND REGULATIONS

OR

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applicable to All Classes of GAS Service

APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

All applications for service will be made on the Company's standard standard application or contract form and will be signed by the Customer, or his duly authorized agent, and accepted by the Company before service is supplied by the Company. A separate application or contract will be made for each class of service at each separate location.

These TERMS AND CONDITIONS apply to all Customers receiving service from the Company.

CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION

All piping and other equipment used in connection with gas service in the premises or connecting said premises with the Company's service, furnished by the Customer, shall be suitable for the purposes hereof and shall be maintained by the Customer at all times in conformity with the requirements of the constituted authorities and with the RULES AND REGULATIONS of the Company in force from time to time.

OWNER'S CONSENT TO OCCUPY

In case the Customer is not the owner of the premises or of the intervening property between the premises and Company's service, the Customer will obtain from the property owner or owners the necessary consent to install and maintain in or over said premises all such piping and other equipment as are necessary or convenient for supplying gas service to the Customer.

ACCESS TO PREMISES

The Company will have the right of access to the Customer's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of installing, reading, inspecting, or repairing any meters, devices, and other equipment used in connection with its supply of gas service, or for the purpose of removing its property and for all other proper purposes.

METERING

The gas consumed shall be measured by a meter or meters to be installed by the Company upon the premises at a point most convenient for the Company's service and upon the registration of said meter or meters all bills shall be calculated. If more than one meter is installed on different classes of

service each class being charged for at different rates, each meter shall be considered by itself in calculating the amount of any bills. Meters include all measuring instruments.

#### PROTECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY

All meters, piping and other appliances and equipment furnished by and at the expense of the Company, which may at any time be in said premises, shall, unless otherwise expressly provided herein, be and remain the property of the Company, and the Customer shall protect such property from loss or damage and no one who is not an agent of the Company shall be permitted to remove such property or tamper therewith.

#### EXCLUSIVE SERVICE ON INSTALLATION CONNECTED

Except in cases where the Customer has a contract with the Company for reserve or auxiliary service, no other gas service will be used by the Customer on the same installation in conjunction with the Company's service, either by means of valves or any other connection.

The Customer will not sell the gas purchased from the Company to any other customer, company, or person, and Customer will not deliver gas purchased from the Company to any connection wherein said gas is to be used off of Customer's premises or by persons over whom Customer has no control.

#### EXTENSION OF SERVICE

For extension of service, other than as provided by rule #46 of the P.S.C.'s Administrative Order No. 5, the main gas lines of the Company, or branches thereof, will be extended to such points as provide sufficient load or revenue, to justify such extensions, or in lieu of sufficient load, the Company may require such definite and written guarantees from a Customer, or group of Customers, in addition to any minimum payments required by the tariff as may be necessary. This requirement may also be made covering the repayment, within a reasonable time, of the cost of tapping such existing lines for gas service.

#### LIABILITY

The Customer assumes all responsibility for the gas service upon the Customer's premises at and from the point of delivery of gas and for the pipes and equipment used in connection therewith, and will protect and save the Company harmless from all claims for injury or damage to persons or property occurring on the Customer's premises or at and from the point of delivery of gas, occasioned by such gas or gas service and equipment, except where said injury or damage will be shown to have been occasioned solely by the negligence of the Company.

#### CONTINUOUS SERVICE

The Company shall not be responsible for any failure to supply gas or for interruption of the supply, if any such failure or interruption is without wrongful default or negligence on its part.

#### DEPOSIT

The Company will have the right at any time to require the Customer to make and maintain a reasonable deposit in advance to secure the prompt pay-

ment of bills. Any portion of such deposit not applied to payment of bills will be refunded when the Customer discontinues service. Interest on this deposit will be paid or credited to customer's account at the rate of 6% per annum.

#### MONTHLY BILLS

(a) Bills for service will be rendered monthly, unless otherwise specified. The term "month" for billing purposes will mean the period between any two consecutive readings of the meters by the Company, such readings to be taken as nearly as practicable every thirty days.

(b) Failure to receive a bill in no way exempts Customers from the provisions of these TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

(c) When the Company is unable to read a meter after reasonable effort, the Customer will be billed at the average of the three immediately preceding months' bills and the billing adjusted when the meter is read.

(d) Customers served under rates that have both gross and net rates will be billed both the gross and net amounts for gas service each month. Where bills are paid on or before ten days from the date of the bill, only the net bill will be collected. Where the bill is paid after the last discount day, no discount will be allowed and the gross bill will be collected.

#### DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

When bills for gas service are in arrears, or in case the Customer fails to comply with these TERMS AND CONDITIONS, the Company will have the right to discontinue all its gas service to the Customer and to remove its property from the Customer's premises upon mailing notice to address to which the monthly bills are sent. For Customers whose service has been disconnected for non-payment of bills there will be a charge of \$1.00 for reconnecting the service.

#### ASSIGNMENT

No application and agreement or contract for service may be assigned or transferred without the written consent of the Company.

#### RENEWAL OF CONTRACT

If, upon the expiration of any service contract for a specified term, the Customer continues to use the service, the contract (unless otherwise provided therein) will automatically be renewed for successive periods of one year each, subject to termination at the end of any year upon thirty days written notice by either party.

#### BENEFITS AND OBLIGATIONS

The benefits and obligations of this agreement shall begin when the Company commences to supply gas service hereunder, and shall inure to and be binding upon the successors and assigns, survivors and executors or administrators, as the case may be, of the original parties hereto respectively, for the full term hereof.

#### AGENTS CANNOT MODIFY AGREEMENT

No agent has power to amend, modify or alter this agreement or waive

any of its conditions or to bind the Company by making any promises or representations not contained herein.

**CUSTOMER'S EQUIPMENT**

The Company reserved the right to specify sized of fixtures, piping, etc., which shall be used by the Customer in connecting the Customer's equipment to the Company's service mains.

**SUPERSEDE PREVIOUS TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

These **TERMS AND CONDITIONS** supersede all Terms and Conditions under which the Company has previously supplied gas service.
