**LARGE VOLUME RATE 3**

Determination of Base Load and Excess Gas:

The BASE LOAD for any billing month shall be the smaller of the following:

- (a) The amount of gas delivered in the month
- (b) The number of days in the month for such billing month multiplied by the average daily delivery during the preceding base load period of June, July, August and September.

For new customers where service is initiated after June 1 of any year, the Company shall have the right to estimate the base load until an actual base load is established. Such estimate shall consider connected load and hours of use.

The EXCESS GAS for such billing month shall be the remainder, if any, after deducting the base load Mcf from the total delivery for such month. During any billing month where customer complied fully with any partial or complete curtailment order of the Company, or where gas is used for processing only with 100% standby available and customer is subject to immediate interruption without advance notice, no gas shall be billed at the excess gas price.

Character of Service:

Natural gas having approximately 1,000 Btu content per cubic foot.

Gas sold under this rate schedule shall be subject to curtailment or complete interruption when gas is needed to safeguard service to customers under the Company's General Service Rate 1, or for other justified reasons at the discretion of the Company, in accordance with the provisions of the contract.

If a customer contracts for gas under this rate schedule and fails to meet the minimum requirements of 500 Mcf per day for Base Load purposes, the contract shall be subject to cancellation, and gas deliveries thereafter shall be billed at the lowest available rate for which the customer qualifies, or if the customer elects, it may discontinue the use of gas entirely.
