(d) Revision of Delivery Volumes:

The Daily Contract Demand for High Priority service and the Daily Contract Demand for Interruptible service shall be subject to revision as necessary so as to coincide with the customer's normal operating conditions and actual load with consideration given to any anticipated changes in customer's utilization, subject to the Company's contractual obligations with other customers, or its supplier, and subject to availability of the gas if an increased volume is involved.

4. RATE - NET:

(a) High Priority Service:

46.0¢ per Mcf for all gas used in this classification within the limits of the High Priority Daily Contract Demand as specified in the contract.

(b) Interruptible Service:

36.0¢ per Mcf for all gas used in this classification within the limits of the Interruptible Daily Contract Demand as specified in the contract.

(c) 46.0¢ per Mcf for the volume of gas equal to the product of the High Priority Daily Contract Demand times the number of days in the monthly billing period, plus 36.0¢ per Mcf for all additional interruptible gas used during the monthly billing period, within the limits of the Daily Contract Demands as specified in the contract.
