Dear Senator Quinlan:

On September 25, 1979, the United States District Court for the western district of Kentucky ruled that the Kentucky Public Service Commission had no authority to regulate the rates of electric utilities in Kentucky that buy their power from the Tennessee Valley Authority. The court's ruling was based upon the fact that Congress gave TVA the power to set the retail rate for all customers who purchase electricity from TVA under a wholesale contract. The power of the federal government to set the retail rate for these utilities takes precedence over the power of the state to likewise set the rate. Accordingly, since 1979 the PSC has not exercised any jurisdiction over the retail rates of the following utilities operating in Kentucky: Hickman-Fulton RECC, Pennyrile RECC, Warren RECC, West Kentucky RECC, Tri-County Electric Membership Corporation, and Jellico Electric Company.

In January of this year, the PSC received correspondence from stating that it was TVA's belief that the principle enunciated in the 1979 federal court decision would apply to service as well as rates. TVA thus contends that none of its wholesale customers operating in Kentucky are subject to any of the PSC's regulations governing the provision of electrical service to customers. The PSC has considered this matter and it is our conclusion that TVA is right on this point and that federal rather than state law governs the service as well as the rates of all TVA-supplied utilities. Since construction projects by utilities are also related to the rates and service of the utilities, the PSC believes it cannot legally certificate construction projects for these utilities. Accordingly, the PSC wishes to inform your committee that our agency will no longer regulate the rates, service, or construction aforementioned six utilities operating in Kentucky which purchase their electricity from the TVA.

- B. Pennyrile Rural Electric will use T.V.A's suggested rotational intervals of two (2) hours off and four (4) on in order to maintain approximately 1/3 of the normal load.
- C. The 1/3 of normal load will be accomplished by interrupting 1/3 of the normal load at each distribution substation on Pennyrile Rural Electric's system. Due to the large service area and the number of circuits from substations Pennyrile will not designate any apecial plan or measures for service to essential loads. From a practical standpoint, if any considerations that can be made without disrupting the overall curtailment plan will be exercised.
- D. The interruption of Firm Load will be done on District levels with the District Manager of his respective District being responsible for executing the plan but under the supervision of the Pennyrile Rural Electric management. In the Hopkinsville District, the Operating Superintendent will be responsible for executing the plan under the supervision of management.
- E. Each respective District will be responsible for notifying public officials and other emergency type organizations as to the load curtailment situation upon receiving notification from Pennyrile Rural Electric management to do so.
- F. All news releases will be initiated by the management of Pennyrile Rural Electric from the main office.

Instead, such customers shall pay a minimum monthly bill of \$5.00 so long as service is connected; shall pay a minimum annual bill which shall in no case be less than (a) 3 cents per kilowatthour of the maximum monthly consumption for customers whose demand does not exceed 50 kilowatts or (b) \$10.00 per kilowatt of the mamimum demand established for customers whose demand is over 50 kilowatts; and shall pay in addition the actual cost of connections and disconnections in excess of connections and disconnections in excess of connections.

Contract Requirement

Distributor may require contracts for all service provided under this rate schedule. Customers whose demand exceeds 50 kilowatts shall be required to execute contracts for an initial term of at least one year. If the customer requires in excess of 5,000 kilowatts, the contract shall be for an initial term of at least five years, and any renewal or extension of the initial contract shall also be for a term of at least five years. - The opening date for signing Budget Billing agreements will be in June, with the first payment due on the July billing.
- Members with residential heat who have been connected at the present В. location for a minimum of seven months, previous to June, will be eligible.
- Budget payments are determined by dividing the cost of the previous year's C. electric service by eleven, rounded to the nearest dollar. In cases of less than twelve months' service, amounts would be estimated to bring the total to twelve.
- Agreement May be Canceled By: D.
 - Termination of service at location covered by agreement.
 - 2. Failure to make any three budget payments by cut-off date.
 - Written request giving thirty days' notice. The agreement is automatically renewed unless canceled by either the member or the Cooperative. MAR 15 1979
 - 4. Failure to pay agreed budget payment.
- Collection of budget payments is to be handled as other bills with regard Ε. to penalties, collection charges, and cut-offs.
- F. Adjustment will be made in June to reconcile the difference between the amount billed and the amount collected for the eleven-month period. The meter of the consumer will be read each month even though the consumer is on budget billing.
- G. Any sizeable increase in load by the consumer should be reported to the Cooperative.

- 16. Voltage Fluctuations Caused by Customer. Electric service must not be used in such a manner as to cause unusual fluctuations or disturbances to Distributor's system. Distributor may require Customer, at his own expense, to install suitable apparatus which will reasonably limit such fluctuations.
- 17. Additional Load. The service connection, transformers, meters, and equipment supplied by Distributor for each Customer have definite capacity, and no addition to the equipment or load connected thereto will be allowed except by consent of Distributor. Failure to give notice of additions or changes in load, and to obtain Distributor's consent for same, shall render Customer liable for any damage to any of Distributor's lines or equipment caused by the additional or changed installation.
- 18. Standby and Resale Service. All purchased electric service (other than emergency or standby service) used on the premises of Customer shall be supplied exclusively by Distributor, and Customer shall not, directly or indirectly, sell, sublet, assign, or otherwise dispose of the electric service or any part thereof.

- 23. Billing Adjusted to Standard Periods. The demand charges and the blocks in the energy charges set forth in the rate schedules are based on billing periods of approximately one month. In the case of the first billing of new accounts (temporary service, cotton gine and other seasonal customers excepted) and final billings of all accounts (temporary service excepted) where the period covered by the billing involves fractions of a month, the demand charges and the blocks of the energy charge will be adjusted to a basis proportionate with the period of time during which service is extended.
- 24. Home Energy Conservation Surveys. All customers of Distributor receiving service under the residential rate schedule are eligible for a free energy conservation survey of their home. As part of such survey information covering efficient utilization of electric energy will be made available, including a wide variety of specific recommendations as to the materials and equipment that would provide effective weatherization and thereby yield the greatest energy savings for the customer. Customers will also be furnished a list of private contractors in their area which install various types of energy-saving materials ar equipment, and instructional material concerning the self-installation of such materials ar equipment.

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- 25. Home Insulation Program. Customers of Distributor receiving service under the residential rate schedule and who heat or cool their homes with electricity or who are converting so as to heat or cool their homes with electricity, are eligible to participate in the home insulation program being conducted by Distributor and TVA. If the home energy conservation survey for such customers indicate home weatherization measures such as storm windows, insulated doors, caulking and weatherstripping of doors and windows, and the installation of attic insulation are cost effective, Distributor will, as part of providing electric service to residential customers, arrange to make available funds provided by TVA to accomplish said measures at customer's dwelling; provided, however, that such financing will not be available for customers who only cool with electricity or who are converting s as to cool with electricity, for stown windows and floor insulation. Participants will be required to enter into a standard form agreement under which the funds furnished to accomplish said measures will be repaid to Distributor in a lump sum payment, or by monthly payments, at no additional charge, extending for a period of up to seven years. The month repayments amount due for this service will be included as part of the electric bill rende by Distributor, to which bills the provisions of the section entitled Billing this Schedule of Rules and Regulations are applicable; provided, however, that said monthly amounts shall not be subject to additional charges for past-due payments. 5 1981

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

REQUEST METER TEST

The Cooperative will test, upon receipt of a written complaint, and the receipt of a \$4.00 complaint test fee, any self-contained one or three-phase commercial or residential meter. If upon test the accuracy of the meter is found to be within the limits set forth in 807 KAR 2.010, Section 9, Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4, the test fee will be retained by the Cooperative. If the accuracy of the meter is found to be outside the limits of 807 KAR 2.010, Section 9, the test fee would be refunded to the member and his previous payments will be adjusted and refunded in accordance with 807 KAR 2.010, Section 9.

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Schedule of Rules and Regulations

- 21. Relocation of Outdoor Lighting Facilities. Mistributor shall, at the request of Customer, relocate or change existing Distributor-owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse Distributor for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overheads.

Mobile Home Service Policy

- 1. All extensions to mobile homes of up to and including 150 feet from the nearest facility shall be made without charge other than membership fee, deposit, inspection, any other regular charges and the signing of a one (1) year contract for a monthly minimum as provided by Pennyrile Rate Schedule.
- 2. Extensions to mobile homes greater than 150 feet from the nearest facility and up to and including 300 feet shall be made provided the customer pays Pennyrile a "customer advance for construction" of fifty (\$50.00) in addition to membership fee, deposit, inspection, and any other regular charges required by Pennyrile. This advance shall be refunded at the end of one (1) year if the service to the mobile home continues for that length of time. If the service does not continue for one year, the fifty dollars is not refundable.
- 3. Extensions to mobile homes greater than 300 feet and up to and including 1,000 feet from the nearest facility shall be made provided the customer pays Pennyrile an advance charge for the portion of the service beyond 300 feet plus fifty dollars (\$50.00) and membership fee, deposit, inspection, and any other regular charges.
 - (a) The advance charge for the portion of the service beyond 300 feet will be the material cost plus the labor cost of that section over 300 feet figured using Pennyrile's most current unit cost, excluding transformers.
 - The 300 feet will always be measured from the take-off facility toward the end of the extension. If the 300 feet ends in mid-span, then the over 300 feet starts at that point and will include the wire in the last half of the span.
 - (c) This advance, including the fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be refunded to original customer over a four (4) year period in equal amounts for each year the service is continued.
 - If the service is discontinued for a period of sixty (60) days, or should the mobile home be removed and another not take its place within (60) days, or not be replaced by a permanent structure, the remainder of the advance shall be forfeited.

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- (e) No refunds shall be made to any customer who did not make the advance originally and keep service in his name over the four (4) year period.
- 4. Extensions to mobile homes greater than 1000 feet from the nearest facility shall be made provided the customer pays Pennyrile an advance charge for the portion of the service between 300 feet and 1000 feet plus an advance charge for the portion of the service beyond 1000 feet plus fifty (\$50.00) and the membership fee, deposit, inspection and any other regular charges.
 - (a) The advance charge and refund schedule for the portion between 300 feet and 1000 feet will be exactly the same as specified in Section 3.
 - (b) The advance charge for the portion beyond 1000 feet will be calculated using the same method specified for portions between 300 feet and 1000 feet.
 - (c) The refund schedule for the portion of the service over 1000 feet will be for a period of ten (10) years. Each year the customer, who paid the advance charge for the portion of 1000 feet, will be refunded for each additional customer connected directly to the extension during the year; but not to extensions or laterals taking off the original extension. In no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period no refund will be required to be made.

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Extensions over one thousand (1,000) feet in length to permanent service

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Pennyrile Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation will extend overhead service to a permanent service (excluding mobile homes and oil wells) of over 1,000 feet under the applicable rate schedule provided:

- 1. When an extension of the utility's line to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than 1,000 feet per customer, the utility may if not inconsistent with its filed tariff require the total cost of the excessive footage over 1,000 feet per customer to be deposited with the utility by the applicant or applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension.
- 2. Each customer receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of this rule shall be the refund period, the utility shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage the cost of 1,000 feet of the extension in place of each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the utility. After the end of the refund period no refund will be required to be made.

With Regard to Underground Facilities

In compliance with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Administrative Case No. 146, the Pennyrile Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation submits this policy for the installation of underground electric facilities in subdivisions in its area.

DEFINITION

The following words and terms, when used in these rules, shall have the meaning indicated:

Applicant - the developer, builder or other person, partnership, association, corporation or governmental agency applying for the installation of an underground electric distribution system.

Building - a structure enclosed within exterior walls or fire walls built, erected and framed or component structural parts and designated for less than five (5) family occupancy.

Multiple-Occupancy Building - a structure enclosed within exterior walls or fire walls, built, erected and framed of component structural parts and designated to contain five (5) or more individual dwelling units.

<u>Distribution System</u> - electric service facilities consisting of primary and secondary conductors, transformers, and necessary accessories and appurtenances for the furnishing of electric power at utilization voltage.

Commission - the Public Service Commission of Kentucky .

<u>Subdivision</u> - the tract of land which is divided into ten (10) or more lots for the construction of new residential buildings, or the land on which is constructed two (2) or more new multiple occupancy buildings.

<u>Utility</u> - the Pennyrile Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation

RIGHTS OF WAY AND EASEMENTS

- 1. The utility shall construct, own, operate and maintain distribution lines only along easements, public streets, roads, and highways which are by legal right accessible to the utility's equipment and which the utility has the legal right to occupy, and on the public lands and private property across which rights of way and easements satisfactory to the utility may be obtained without cost of condemnation by the utility.
- 2. Rights of way & easements suitable to the utility for the underground distribution facilities must be furnished by the applicant in reasonable time to meet service requirements. The utility will require that the applicant make the area in which the underground distribution facilities are to be located accessible to the utility's equipment, remove all obstructions from such area, stake to show property lines and final grade, perform rough grading to a reasonable approximation of final grade, and maintain clearing and grading during construction by the utility. The utility may require that suitable land rights be granted to it, obligation the applicant and subsequent property owners to provide continuing access to the utility for operation, maintenance or replacement of its facilities, and to prevent any encroachment in the utility's easement or substantial changes in grade or elevation thereof.

| POLICY FOR UNDERGROUND DISTRIBUTION SY | STEMS WITHIN A NEW SUBDIVISION |

- Where appropriate contractual arrangements have been made, the utility shall install within the subdivision an underground electric distribution system of sufficient capacity and suitable materials which, in its judgement, will assure that the property owners will receive safe and adequate electric service for the forseeable future.
 - Facilities required to be underground:
 - All single phase conductors installed by the utility shall be underground. Appurtenances such as transformers, pedestal-mounted terminals, switching equipment, and meter cabinets will be placed above ground; the differential cost of underground shall be borne by the applicant.
 - Three (3) phase primary mains or feeders required within a subdivision to supply local distribution or to serve individual three-phase loads may be overhead unless underground is required by governmental authority or chosen by the applicant, in either of which case the differential cost of underground shall be borne by the applicant.
- If the applicant has complied with the requirements herein and with the utility specifications on file with the Commission, and has given the utility not less than 120 days' written notice prior to the anticipated date of completion (i.e., ready for occupancy) of the first building in the subdivision, the utility shall complete the installation 30 days prior to the estimated completion date. (Subject to weather and ground conditions and availability of materials and barring extraordinary or emergency circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the utility.) However, nothing in

these regulations shall be interpreted to require the utility to extend service to portions of the subdivisions not under active development.

SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

- 1. The developer will pay the utility \$2.00 per foot, representing the difference in the cost of overhead and underground distribution primary facilities, non refundable.
- 2. Should it be the desire of the developer to develop the subdivision by sections it is recognized that the utility would be required to make expenditures (heavier conductor, and in instances three-phase lines) in advance of their immediate requirements to serve the other portions of the subdivision at a future date, or until the developer desires to complete the undeveloped area, under these conditions, the utility would charge an amount not to exceed 31½ cents per foot for three phase primary lines, and 21½ cents per foot for single phase primary lines installed initially. This amount will be paid by the developer in advance of construction, and is not refundable.
- 3. When a subdivision consisting of 10 or more lots is developed at one time (within 12 months), a deposit of 31½ cents per foot for three phase primary lines, and 21½ cents per foot for single phase lines shall be made by developer to be refunded after 12 months' time, provided 70 percent of the lots in the subdivision have been completed and are occupied by permanent residents. In the event the developer fails to meet the 70 percent occupancy schedule at the end of 12 months, then the following refund schedule would apply.

- 6. At the request of the developer, or a municipality, in which the subdivision might be situated, street lighting with its underground lines would be installed with the developer or municipality opening the trench and back filling it to the utility's specifications, without charge by the utility for the installations, provided there is assurance that the street lighting system will remain in service for ten or more years.

UNDERGROUND PRIMARY AND TRANSFORMER INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS IN SUBDIVISIONS

- 1. The developer will be required to open all trenches and back fill all trenches within P.R.E.C.C. specifications and without cost to P.R.E.C.C. Trenches are to be 48 inches in depth from finish to grade.
- 2. The developer is to provide a 10 foot easement on all front property lines. Before an easement is designated, all utilities involved should agree on the required easement needed. Also, easements should be stated to include the service to the point of attachment on the individual lots.
- 3. All the primary underground cables will be in front of the lots within the resignated easements.
- 4. All transformers will be pad mounts located above ground and within the designated easements.
- 5. Pennyrile will not allow any other utility to be in the same trench with them.
- 6. The crossings of other utilities are to meet specifications of REA Form 806, January, 1975.
- 7. All crossings of public streets and private driving areas are to be made more in either rigid conduit or PVE Spec 40 conduit which is to be furnished and installed by the developer. The size conduit will be determined by Pennyrile in accordance with the size cable used. A pull rope is to be provided for use in pulling the cable.
- 8. In the event that any rock, solid or loose, is encountered, the developer is to furnish either rigid conduit or PVC Spec 40 conduit and is to be installed



- Pennyrile Rural Electric's levels of load reduction are as follows:
 - Step 40, Level 1; 20% reduction of load (1)
 - Step 40, Level 2; additional 20% reduction of load
 - Step 40, Level 3; additional 20% reduction of load (3)
 - Step 40, Level 4; additional 20% reduction of load (4)
 - (5) Step 40, Level 5; additional 20% reduction except for minimum amount of load necessary for plant safety and security.

- C. The 1/3 of normal load will be accomplished by interrupting 1/3 of the normal load at each distribution substation on Pennyrile Rural Electric's system. Due to the large service area and the number of circuits from substations Pennyrile will not designate any apecial plan or measures for service to essential loads. From a practical standpoint, if any considerations that can be made without disrupting the overall curtailment plan will be exercised.
- D. The interruption of Firm Load will be done on District levels with the District Manager of his respective District being responsible for executing the plan but under the supervision of the Pennyrile Rural Electric management. In the Hopkinsville District, the Operating Superintendent will be responsible for executing the plan under the supervision of management.
- E. Each respective District will be responsible for notifying public officials and other emergency type organizations as to the load curtailment situation upon receiving notification from Pennyrile Rural Electric management to do so.
- F. All news releases will be initiated by the management of Pennyrile Rural Electric from the main office.
