- Application for service. Each prospective Customer desiring electric service may be required to sign Distributor's standard form of application for service or contract before service is supplied by the Distributor.
- Deposit. A deposit or suitable guarantee approximately equal to twice the average monthly bill may be required of any Customer before electric service is supplied. Distributor may at its option return deposit to Customer after one year. - 4. Customer's Wiring--Standards. All wiring of Customer must conform to Distributor's requirements and accepted modern standards, as exemplified by the requirement's of the National Electrical safety Code and the National Electrical Code.

Athletic field lighting installations not owned or maintained by Distributor may be served on an off-peak basis in accordance with the provisions of the street lighting rate. For athletic field lighting the investment charge provided for in the street lighting rate will be based on the Distributor's investment in furnishing and installing the equipment devoted to supplying the athletic field lighting service. Energy will be billed in accordance with the street lighting schedule and each installation will be considered a separate customer for billing purposes. Customer's bills rendered in accordance with this provision shall be subject to any surcharge and amortization charge applied by Distributor. 



(2) 5 cents per kw of billing demand for each 5 cents or major fraction thereof by which TVA's cost of money (interest charges to operations plus return on the appropriation investment) per kw of the sum of the monthly billing demands of power sold by TVA as determined by TVA from its records exceeded or was less than 40 cents, respectively, during the most recently completed fiscal year ending June.

Under C above, the minimum monthly bill for demand and energy shall be in no case less than \$1.25 per kilowatt of the contract demand or any higher demand established during the preceding 12 months. Distributor may require minimum bills higher than those stated above.

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE: (e)

Above rates, including surcharge, are net (discounted). In the event that any bill is not paid within 10 days from date of bill, there shall be added to the bill an amount equal to 10 percent on the first \$250.00 of the bill plus one percent on any portion of the bill exceeding \$250.00. To any amount remaining unpaid 30 days after the date of the bill, there shall be added a penalty of one percent, and an additional one percent shall be added at the end of each successive 30-day period until the amount is paid in full.
